# Atal Bhujal Yojana launched by Government of India

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched Atal Bhujal Yojana (ATAL JAL) which aims to improve groundwater management. The scheme has been designed with the principal objective of strengthening the institutional framework for participatory groundwater management.
- It aims to bring behavioral changes at the community level for sustainable groundwater resource management in 7 States: Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh.
- The scheme will promote panchayat led ground water management and behavioural change with primary focus on demand side management.
- The Government has outlaid Rs. 6000 crore for the scheme. Out of the total outlay of Rs. 6000 crore to be implemented over a period of 5 years (2020-21 to 2024-25), 50% shall be in the form of World Bank loan, and to be repaid by the Central Government.
- The remaining 50% shall be through Central Assistance from regular budgetary support. The entire World Bank's loan component and Central Assistance will be passed on to the States as Grants.

### Nadal and Barty named 2019 ITF World Champions

 Ashleigh Barty and Rafael Nadal were named International Tennis Federation's (ITF) World Champions in singles for 2019. The awards will be given at the 2020 ITF world champions 2nd June, in Paris.

# Tamil Nadu tops 'Good Governance Index' launched by GoI


- The Central Government has released the "Good Governance Index" on the occasion of Good Governance Day to assess the state of governance in Indian States and Union Territories.
- The prime objective of the GGI is to provide quantifiable data to compare the state of governance in all states and Union Territories, enable them to formulate and implement suitable strategies for improving governance and shift to result oriented approaches and administration.
- The Index was launched by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances, and the Centre for Good Governance.
- The GGI takes into consideration ten sectors. These ten Governance Sectors are measured on total 50 indicators. The 10 sectors are: Agriculture and Allied Sectors; Commerce & Industries; Human Resource Development; Public Health; Public Infrastructure & Utilities; Economic Governance; Social Welfare & Development; Judicial & Public Security; Environment; Citizen-Centric Governance.
- The states and UTs are divided into three groups:
  Big States, North-East & Hill States and Union
  Territories.

Some key results of the Index:

 Among the "Big States", Tamil Nadu topped the Good Governance Index. The poor performers are Odisha, Bihar, Goa, and Uttar Pradesh with Jharkhand finishing last in the group.







- Among the "North-East and Hill States", Himachal Pradesh topped the index, followed by Uttarakhand, Tripura, Mizoram and Sikkim. The worst performers in this group are Jammu and Kashmir, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, with Arunachal Pradesh finishing last in the group.
- Among the "Union Territories", Puducherry topped the index followed by Chandigarh and Delhi. Lakshwadeep is the worst performing UT.

# RBI caps lending on P2P platforms at Rs 50 lakh

- The Reserve Bank of India has capped the permissible exposure limit of a lender on a Peerto-Peer lending (P2P) platform for all borrowers. The aggregate exposure has been set at Rs 50 lakh at any given point of time. The step has been taken to protect the consumers interest.
- The lender investing more than Rs 10 lakh across P2P platforms has to produce a certificate to P2P platforms from a practising Chartered Accountant certifying minimum net-worth of Rs 50 lakh.
- The central bank also stated that the "Escrow accounts" to be operated by bank promoted trustee for transfer of funds need not be mandatorily maintained with the bank which has promoted the trustee. It also mandates that all the transactions through bank accounts, and cash transaction are strictly prohibited.

# Kamareddy wins Unicef-2019 Award for Swachh Bharat implementation

 Kamareddy district of Telangana has secured the United Nations International Children's and Education Fund (Unicef)-2019 Award for effective implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission in water sanitation and hygiene sectors.

- The Government of India has constructed Girls' Hostel for Nepal Armed Police Force School, Kirtipur, Nepal. The new infrastructure is constructed with the Gol's grant assistance of 40.42 million Nepali Rupees.
- President Ram Nath Kovind released the mobile app of the Red Cross Society of India, developed by the Telangana Centre for Good Governance.
- Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban has achieved its target of creating **Urban India Open Defecation Free** as urban areas of 35 states and Union Territories have become ODF.
- Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister unveiled India's 1st long-distance CNG bus fitted with CNG cylinders in New Delhi. It can travel around 1000 kilometres in a single fill and will ply from Delhi to Dehradun.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi named **Rohtang** passageway in **Himachal Pradesh** as **Atal Tunnel** to mark the 95th birth anniversary of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee.
- 5 verticals of Quality Mandate developed by UGC was launched in New Delhi to equip country's next-generation with vital skills, knowledge and ethics for leading a rewarding life. The 5 documents covers evaluation reforms, eco-friendly and sustainable university campuses, human values & professional ethics, faculty induction and academic research integrity.
- The Union Health Minister has inaugurated the 2nd edition of "Eat Right Mela" in New Delhi organized by Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI). 'The PURPLE Book' a handbook on diets for diseases was also launched during the event.
- Network for Scientific Co-operation for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition (NetSCoFAN), a network of research & academic institutions working in the area of food & nutrition along with the NetSCoFAN directory was launched during the "Eat Right Mela".
- Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT) railway station in Mumbai has been conferred with 'Eat Right Station' certification with the five-star rating by the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) for food safety and hygiene.
- All India Radio organized the National Symposium of Poets 2020 which was attended by select poets of all 22 languages recognized in the constitution.


- Chief Minister of Sikkim has laid the foundation stone of 2 Integrated Organic Food Processing units of Sikkim IFFCO Organics Ltd. (a joint venture between IFFCO and Government of Sikkim) in Rangpo, East Sikkim.
- Rajasthan Chief Minister inaugurated its first "Janta clinic" in the Malviya Nagar area of Jaipur. The clinic will provide free primary health care to people living in slums.
- Andhra Pradesh chief minister YS Jaganmohan Reddy launched the 'YSR Nethanna Nestham' scheme at Dharmavaram in Anantapur district to provide financial assistance of Rs 24,000 annually to handloom weavers across the state.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi unveiled a statue of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee at Lok Bhawan in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh and also laid the foundation stone for the Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University in the Uttar Pradesh capital.
- In Jharkhand, Grand Alliance leader Hemant Soren will take oath as Chief Minister of the state.
- The 1st edition of Mandu Festival begins at Mandu, picturesque fort city of Madhya Pradesh and organized by Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board.

#### **International Affairs**

- Ecuador has activated the emergency protocols in the Galapagos Islands to contain the environmental impact of a fuel spill in the Galapagos Islands. The step was taken after the accident occurred in a port on San Cristobal Island when a crane collapsed while loading a container onto the barge.
- Eight West African countries: Benin, Burkina Faso, Guinea-Bissau, Ivory Coast, Mali, Niger, Senegal and Togo have agreed to change the name of their common currency to Eco and severed their earlier currency CFA Franc's links to former colonial ruler France.
- David Calhoun will replace Dennis Muilenburg as the CEO of the world's largest aerospace company Boeing.
- China has successfully launched its largest carrier rocket "Long March-5" also known as "CZ-5" from Wenchang Space Launch Center in south China's Hainan Province. It carried a communication satellite "Shijian-20".
- Russia's 1st missile unit equipped with Avangard
   Hypersonic glide vehicle with latest strategic

**missiles of intercontinental range**, enters into service.



### **Agreements/MoUs Signed**

- Wipro has partnered with Nasscom to train students on emerging technologies such as artificial intelligence, data science, internet of things, cybersecurity as a part of it's corporate social responsibility programme "TalentNext". The programme will be extended to students through Future Skills, a Nasscom platform.
- Bank of Baroda has signed an MoU with the Gujarat government to facilitate the flow of credit in the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) sector for greenfield projects, startups, women entrepreneurs and entrepreneurs from backward areas.
- Federal Bank has tied up with online real estate platform Magicbricks for listing and e-auctioning of immovable properties repossessed by it in recovery proceedings.
- **Kotak Mahindra Bank** has tied up with **Pine Labs** to enable debit card facility for their debit cardholders across point-of-sale terminals by Pine Labs. Banks customers can avail EMI facility with a minimum purchase of Rs 8,000 and repay over 3 months to 12 months.

### **Banking/Economy/Business News**

- The Government of India has approved the release of Rs 8,655 crore as fresh capital to three public sector banks: Allahabad Bank (Rs 2,153 crore), Indian Overseas Bank (Rs 4,630 crore) and UCO Bank (Rs 2,142 crore) for preferential allotment of shares.
- The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank has announced a loan of \$210 million for irrigation and solar energy projects in India. The bank will lend \$145 million to improve irrigation services and strengthen flood risk management in West Bengal and \$65 million for a 250-megawatt solar project in Rajasthan.
- The Reserve Bank of India has introduced a new semi-closed prepaid payment instrument (PPI) which can be used for the transaction of goods and services up to a limit of Rs 10,000. The loading facility of the instrument will be linked only from a bank account.
- The Reserve Bank of India has directed large cooperative banks to report all exposures of Rs 5 crore and more to the Central Repository of Information on Large Credits (CRILC) with effect from December 31, 2019. The CRILC was created by the Reserve Bank of India.

- In **Cuba**, President has appointed **Manuel Marrero Cruz** as the country's **first prime minister** in more than 40 years since its scrapping in 1976.
- Dr Monisha Ghosh has been appointed as the first woman Chief Technology Officer at the US government's powerful Federal Communications Commission (FCC). She will replace Dr Eric Burger.
- Sangita Reddy, Joint Managing Director of Apollo Hospitals Group, has taken over as the President of the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FICCI) for 2019-20. She will succeed Sandip Somany.
- Harsh Vardhan Shringla has been appointed as the new Foreign Secretary. He will take over from incumbent Vijay Gokhale.
- Niranjan Hiranandani will succeed Balkrishan Goenka as the new president of The Associated Chambers of Commerce & Industry of India (Assocham), the country's apex organisation of industry and trade.

- The Indian Coast Guard has conducted a regional level pollution response exercise named 'Swachchh Samundra NW-2019' at sea off Vadinar in Gulf of Kutch.
- Quick Reaction Surface to Air Missile system developed by DRDO was successfully flight-tested from Integrated Test Range, Chandipur off the Odisha coast.
- The **Indian Air Force** bids farewell to the iconic "MiG-27" with a decommissioning ceremony at the **Jodhpur air base**.
