Most Important Current Affairs of February

India ranked 2nd in producer of Crude Steel

- As per World Steel Association data, India became the second-largest steel producer of crude steel after China 2019, by replacing Japan. India's crude steel production in 2019 was at 111.2 MT, an increase of 1.7 per cent from 109.3 MT in 2018. China remains number one with 996.3 million tonnes in 2019. The United States and Russia rank fourth and fifth respectively.

- The World Breastfeeding Trends Initiative (WBTi) was developed by the experts at the Breastfeeding Promotion Network of India.

The grand slam Australian Open is held annually at Melbourne Park in Melbourne, Australia. The Australian Open was started in 1905 in only Men Singles category, by the Lawn Tennis Association of Australasia (Now Australia). The first Australian Open having the category "Women's Singles" was held in 1922.
- In Australian Open 2020, **Novak Djokovic** defeated Dominic Thiem to win the **Men's Singles title** while **Sofia Kenin** defeated Garbiñe Muguruza to win the **Women's Singles title**.

National Affairs

- The Supreme Court has directed the states to establish Gram Nyayalayas within four weeks under Gram Nyayalayas Act,2008, to provide speedy and inexpensive justice to people in rural areas at their doorsteps.
- **Jaipur "The Pink City"** has been certified by the United Nations Educational Scientific and Cultural Organisation (**UNESCO**) as the World Heritage site.
- Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog has begin a series of innovation demo days which aims to unite the stakeholders of the food processing and agriculture sector in India. The first innovation demo day was held in **New Delhi**.



- The Union Cabinet has approved to bestow the status of Institution of National Importance to the five Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs).
- The Union Cabinet has given its in-principle approval to set up a new Major Port at Vadhavan near **Dahanu** in **Maharashtra** on the basis of land lord model.
- India's biggest rural technical festival titled 'Antahpragnya 2020' was held in Basar, Nirmal District of Telangana with the theme "Spot and encourage rural tech innovators".

States in the News

- Madhya Pradesh government has entered into an agreement with the Survey of India, to employ drones for mapping of villages.
- To ensure the home delivery of the government services, Karnataka Government has launched a scheme "Janasevaka".

International Affairs

- Katy Perry has become the ambassador of the British Asian Trust's Children's Protection Fund for India, recently unveiled by Britain's Prince Charles.
- Romania's pro-European government led by Prime Minister Ludovic Orban has collapsed in a parliamentary no-confidence vote after only 3 months in office.
- The United States President Donald Trump has been acquitted of all impeachment charges.
- Sri Lanka celebrated its 72nd Independence Day on 4th February 2020. The major change in the celebration ceremony was the National Anthem of Sri Lanka as it was sung only in Sinhala and not in Tamil language.
- Mohammed Tawfiq Allawi was appointed as Iraq's new Prime Minister by President Barhim Salih.
 Former PM Adil Abdul-Mahdi resigned in November 2019 due to anti-government protests.
- Maldives has returned to Commonwealth after its exit in 2016 and hence, has become the 54th member of the global body.
- Prime Minister of Pakistan Imran Khan has declared a national emergency in the country to battle locust swarms.
- NASA's astronaut Christina Koch has returned to Earth after her record stay of 328 days in space and surpassed Peggy Whitson's record for an American woman on a single spaceflight at 289 days.

Agreements/MoUs Signed

- Indian Oil Corporation and Russian Rosneft has signed a term contract for importing 2 Million Metric Tonnes of Urals grade crude oil to India for the year 2020.
- Indian Oil has picked up a minority equity stake in Israel's battery developer Phinergy to jointly set up a facility in India to manufacture metal-air batteries for electric vehicles.
- **Eastern Railways** has partnered with **Amazon India** to set up a pick-up kiosk at the Sealdah railway station in Kolkata, West Bengal.

Banking/Economy/Business News

- The **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) will conduct the "**Financial Literacy Week 2020**" from February 10 to February 14, 2020. The **theme** will be "Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (**MSMEs**)".
- Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation has increased the insurance coverage for depositors in all insured banks from Rs 1 lakh to Rs 5 lakh with effect from February 4, 2020.
- The Union Cabinet has empowered Reserve Bank of India to have better control over urban cooperative banks and multi-state cooperative banks. The bank is empowered after the amendments in the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.
- Reliance General Insurance Company Limited has launched a comprehensive health insurance plan named "Reliance Health Infinity" which offers 90 days pre and 180 days post hospitalization cover.
- Paytm has launched an Android POS device for small and medium businesses (SMEs) & merchant partners to enable the merchants to accept payments in various ways like debit and credit cards, Paytm Wallet, UPI-based apps and cash.

- Union government has set a defense export target of 5 billion dollars in the upcoming five years (approx 35,000 crore rupees).
- Hindustan Aeronautics Limited has signed a partnership pact with Israel Aerospace Industries to manufacture advanced Unmanned Combat Aerial Vehicles (UCAVs) in India.
- India hosted the Ministerial-level Defence dialogue between India and South Korea in New Delhi to deepen bilateral defence cooperation between the two countries.
- The **Indian Navy** conducts a coastal security exercise named 'Malta Abhiyan' in Kolkata, West Bengal.


