

### Solutions

Sol. **1-4 (fundamental-euphoria)** is the correct combination of the words that should replace each other in order to make the sentence grammatically and contextually correct. Hence, **option (a)** is the right answer choice.

S3. Ans. (c)

Sol. **3-1 (catalyst-vital)** is the correct combination of the words that should replace each other in order to make the sentence grammatically and contextually correct. Hence, **option (c)** is the right answer choice.

S4. Ans. (b)

Sol. **2-3 (experiences- need)** is the correct combination of the words that should replace each other in order to make the sentence grammatically and contextually correct. Hence, **option (b)** is the right answer choice.

S5. Ans. (d)

Sol. **2-3 (organized-employees)** is the correct combination of the words that should replace each other in order to make the sentence grammatically and contextually correct. Hence, **option (d)** is the right answer choice.

S6. Ans. (b)

Sol. **'Stagneted'** is incorrect. The correct word will be **stagnated**. Hence, **option (b)** is the right answer choice.

S7. Ans. (e)

Sol. The given words are correct. Hence, **option (e)** is the right answer choice.

S8. Ans. (b)

Sol. **Weigs** wrong here. The correct spelling will be **Weighs**. Hence, **option (b)** is the right answer choice.

S9. Ans. (a)

Sol. **Acknowldged** is wrong. The correct spelling is **'Acknowledged'**. Hence, **option (a)** is the right answer choice.
