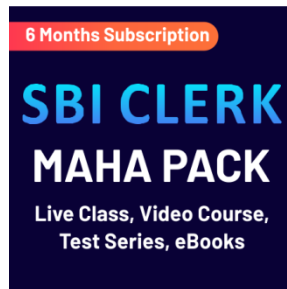

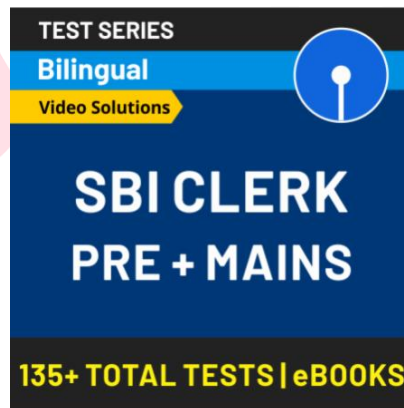

S1. Ans. (c)

Sol. **Undoubtedly** is wrong here. The correct word is **undoubtedly**. Hence, **option (c)** is the right answer choice.

S2. Ans. (d)

Sol. **Trasnfered** is wrong here. The correct word is **transferred**. Hence, **option (d)** is the right answer choice.

S3. Ans. (a)

Sol. **Contentious** is wrong here. The correct word is **contentious**. Hence, **option (a)** is the right answer choice.

S4. Ans. (e)

Sol. Here, all the highlighted words are correct. Hence, **option (e)** is the right answer choice.

S5. Ans. (b)

Sol. **Reportes** is wrong here. The correct word is **Reports**. Hence, **option (b)** is the right answer choice.

S6. Ans. (c)

Sol. **'including-territories'** will replace each other in order to make the sentence grammatically and contextually correct. Hence, **option (c)** is the right answer choice.

S7. Ans. (b)

Sol. **'maritime-terrorism'** will replace each other in order to make the sentence grammatically and contextually correct. Hence, **option (b)** is the right answer choice.

S8. Ans. (d)

Sol. **'trial-arrests'** will replace each other in order to make the sentence grammatically and contextually correct. Hence, **option (d)** is the right answer choice.

S9. Ans. (a)

Sol. **'World-clear'** will replace each other in order to make the sentence grammatically and contextually correct. Hence, **option (a)** is the right answer choice.

S10. Ans. (d)

Sol. **'Adoption-increased'** will replace each other in order to make the sentence grammatically and contextually correct. Hence, **option (d)** is the right answer choice.

S11. Ans. (c)

Sol. **'charged'** should be replaced by 'charging'. Hence, **option (c)** is the right answer choice.

S12. Ans. (a)

Sol. **'at'** should be used in place of **'by'**. Since, we are **'annoyed at something'** or **'annoyed with someone'**. Hence, **option (a)** is the right answer choice.

S13. Ans. (a)

Sol. **'mob'** is a singular subject, singular verb will be used. **'was'** should be used instead of **'were'**. Hence, **option (a)** is the right answer choice.

S14. Ans. (b)

Sol. 'thronged' is followed by 'with'. So, 'by' should be replaced with 'with'. Hence, option (b) is the right answer choice.

S15. Ans. (b)

Sol. 'in' should be used in place of 'by'. Since the preposition 'in' is used after 'engulfed'. Hence, option (b) is the right answer choice.
