Each one of them like different colours viz. Brown, Yellow, Black, Purple, Pink, White, Orange and Red. The one who sit in the middle of the sides face the centre while those who sit at the four corners face outside (i.e. opposite to the centre). The one who faces the centre likes Brown Colour. J does not like yellow colour. The one who likes black colour is one of the immediate neighbours of Y. The one who likes Brown colour sits immediate left of the person one who likes black colour. Only one person sits between Z and W. W sits third to the right of X. J is one of the immediate neighbours of Z. The one who faces the outside of the center likes Pink Colour. The one who likes Purple faces the W. Y does not like Purple colour. The persons who like Orange and White sit next to each other. X does not like Pink colour. K sits second to the right of J. Only three persons sit between J and I. X sits on one of the corners of the table. V sits to the immediate right of I. The persons who like Yellow and Pink colour sits on the corners and opposite to each other. The person who like Orange sit immediate right of the person who likes Red colour.

A word and number arrangement machine when given an input line of words and numbers rearranges them following a particular rule in each step. The following is an illustration of input and rearrangement.

Input: 30 under 56 remains 27 evolution 23 tree 20 pure 15 awareness.

Step I: 20 30 under 56 remains evolution 23 tree pure 15 awareness 27.

Step II: pure 20 30 56 remains evolution 23 tree 15 awareness 27 under.

Step III: 30 pure 20 56 remains evolution tree 15 awareness 27 under 23.

Step IV: remains 30 pure 20 56 tree 15 awareness 27 under 23 evolution.

Step V: 56 remains 30 pure 20 tree awareness 27 under 23 evolution 15.

Step VI: tree 56 remains 30 pure 20 27 under 23 evolution 15 awareness.

Step VI is the last step of the above arrangement.

- (3) If both the first and the last letters are Consonants and there are two or more vowels between them, then those vowels are to be coded as 8.
- (4) If the first letter is vowel and the last letter is a consonant, both are to be coded as the code for the consonant.



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Solutions



Solutions (6-10):

- **Sol.** Students let us understand the Logic behind this Question and let's understand how to solve it. As a first step lets first understand the logic behind the Output. If you will see the final output, you will observe the following:
- (i) The words and numbers are arranged in alternatively in every step starting from the numbers.
- (ii) Two words/number are arranged in each step. Even numbers are arranged at the leftmost end in increasing order (smallest number is arranged first followed by the next smaller number and so on) while the odd numbers are arranged at the rightmost end in decreasing order in each alternate step.
- (iii) The words starting with a consonant is are arranged at the left most end in increasing alphabetical order (cold is arranged before delicate) while the words starting with a vowel are arranged at the rightmost end in decreasing alphabetical order in each step.

Input: cold 40 37 international delicate 50 25 underneath along pool 33 18 38 massage 21 expert.

Step I: 18 cold 40 international delicate 50 25 underneath along pool 33 38 massage 21 expert 37.

Step II: cold 18 40 international delicate 50 25 along pool 33 38 massage 21 expert 37 underneath.

Step III: 38 cold 18 40 international delicate 50 25 along pool massage 21 expert 37 underneath 33.

Step IV: delicate 38 cold 18 40 50 25 along pool massage 21 expert 37 underneath 33 internationals.

Step V: 40 delicate 38 cold 18 50 along pool massage 21 expert 37 underneath 33 international 25.

Step VI: massage 40 delicate 38 cold 18 50 along pool 21 37 underneath 33 international 25 expert.

Step VII: 50 massage 40 delicate 38 cold 18 along pool 37 underneath 33 international 25 expert 21.

Step VIII: pool 50 massage 40 delicate 38 cold 18 37 underneath 33 international 25 expert 21 along.
