

SEBI Grade A English Language (Solutions)

S1. Ans.(e)

Sol. 'Inborn' means 'innate' or 'inherent'. The meaning conveyed by the sentence is, 'when you are living with values that come from within you then you can be open, honest and vehement' ('vehement' meaning 'marked by great energy or vigour'). In option (a), 'core' means 'candid' (frank). Option (e) is better suited to the given statement.

S2. Ans.(c)

Sol. Only option (c) will suit the two blanks. 'Concentrate' should be followed by 'upon' and not 'to'; 'consider' (v. transitive) should be followed by a noun or pronoun (consider what or whom?)

S3. Ans.(d)

Sol. 'Continuing' here means 'ongoing'; dizzying refers to 'a very fast speed' or 'rapidly'.

S4. Ans.(a)

Sol. It is to be noted that 'harassment' cannot be called anything but a plain 'wrong'; it is not 'murder', 'killing', 'falsehood' or an 'offence'. So it should be clear that option (a) is the answer at the first glance. But even where the second blank is concerned, only 'excuse' will fit it well.

S5. Ans.(b)

Sol. Only 'inquisitive' and 'curious' will fit the first blank owing to the sentence that follows-'He likes to know how things work.' But only 'legitimate' of option (b) will suit the second blank, not 'philosophical' of option (d).

S6. Ans.(b)

Sol. Remove 'in' as before the time denoting word like 'week' if we use next, last etc. then we don't use preposition before it.

S7. Ans.(d)

Sol. Use 'speeches' in place of 'speech' as after 'one of' we use noun in plural form.

S8. Ans.(a)

Sol. Use 'was' in place of 'were' as committee is a singular subject.

S9. Ans.(a)

Sol. Use 'was' in place of 'is' as we are talking about something in past.

S10. Ans.(b)

Sol. use 'time' in place of 'timing'.

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S11. Ans.(a)

Sol. Replace 'among' with 'between' as we use among to talk about things which are not clearly separated but here there is talk for two companies.

S12. Ans.(b)

Sol. Replace 'underwent' with 'undergone' as third form of the verb is to be used here with has.

S13. Ans.(b)

Sol. Replace 'detail' with 'detailed'.

S14. Ans.(e)

Sol. Replace 'less' with 'least' here the use of least will be correct because 350 billion is the minimum requirement.

S15. Ans.(a)

Sol. In place of 'no' use 'any' as the use of lack is already negative.
