No two persons can sit together according to alphabetical order (e.g. A can't sit with B and B can't sit with C and so on). Not more than two persons who sit together face same direction. B sits immediate left of D. **F does not like city.** The one who likes yellow sits second right of A. G likes blue. H sits third left of the one who likes Delhi. C and A does not sit on same side.
