Sol. **Cheer up (someone)** means make a sad person feel happy. Hence, **option (c)** is the right answer choice.

Sol. **Give (something) out** means **distribute**. Hence, **option (b)** is the right answer choice.

S3. Ans. (e)

Sol. **Pick (something or someone up)** means get a person in your car and take him/her to another place. Hence, **option (e)** is the right answer choice.

Sol. **Looking into** means **investigate**. Hence, **option (d)** is the right answer choice.

S5. Ans. (d)

Sol. **Settled on** means **decide on, choose**. Hence, **option (d)** is the right answer choice.

Sol. **Touched on** means mention briefly during a speech or discussion. Hence, **option (a)** is the right answer choice.
