Directions (1-5): In these questions, relationship between different elements is shown in the statements. The statements are followed by conclusions. Study the conclusions based on the given statements and select the appropriate answer. Give answer-

- (a) If only conclusion II is true
- (b) If only conclusion I is true
- (c) If both conclusions I and II are true.
- (d) If either conclusion I or II is true
- (e) If neither conclusion I nor II is true.

Q1. Statements:  $S \leq L \leq I = P \geq E > R; L > Q$   
Conclusions: I.  $P \geq S$       II.  $I > R$

Q2. Statements:  $G > R \geq E = A \leq T \leq S; D \leq A \leq J$   
Conclusions: I.  $T \geq D$       II.  $R > S$

Q3. Statements:  $A \geq B > C \leq D \leq E < F$   
Conclusions: I.  $A \geq E$       II.  $C < F$

Q4. Statements:  $G > R \geq E = A \leq T \leq S; D \leq A \leq J$   
Conclusions: I.  $J > G$       II.  $J = G$

Q5. Statements:  $S \leq L \leq I = P \geq E > R; L > Q$   
Conclusions: I.  $L < R$       II.  $E \geq Q$

Directions (6-10): In the given questions, assuming the given statements to be true, find which of the given four conclusions numbered I, II, III and IV is/are definitely true and give you answer accordingly.

- (a) If only conclusion I is true.
- (b) If only conclusion II is true.
- (c) If either I or II is true.
- (d) If neither I nor II is true.
- (e) If both I and II are true.

Q6. Statements:  $P \geq S < R, T = Q > P, U \leq L < T$   
Conclusions: I.  $T > S$       II.  $R \geq T$

Q7. Statements:  $A = C \geq E = B, F \leq G = D < A$   
Conclusions: I.  $F \leq E$       II.  $A > G$

Q8. Statements:  $J \leq M < K = H, N = S > P \geq H$   
Conclusions: I.  $K = N$       II.  $J < S$

Q9. Statements:  $U \geq X = V < W, R \geq T > Y = W$   
Conclusions: I.  $T > X$       II.  $R > V$

Q10. Statements:  $G \leq S = E < W, D > K = A \geq G$

Conclusions: I.  $D \leq E$       II.  $K \leq S$

Directions (11-15): In the following questions, the symbols @, ©, %, \* and \$ are used with the following meaning as illustrated below:

'P © Q' means 'P is not greater than Q'.

'P \$ Q' means 'P is not smaller than Q'.

'P @ Q' means 'P is neither smaller than nor greater than Q'.

'P \* Q' means 'P is neither equal to nor greater than Q'.

'P % Q' means 'P is neither smaller than nor equal to Q'.

Now in each of the following questions, assuming the given statements to be true, find which of the three conclusions I, II and III given below them is/are definitely true and give your answer accordingly

Q11. Statements:  $M @ L © R * A \$ B$

Conclusions: I.  $R * B$       II.  $A \% L$       III.  $A \% M$

- (a) None is true
- (b) Only I is true
- (c) Only II is true
- (d) Both II and III are true
- (e) Only III is true

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Q12. Statements:  $R \$ N * M © K @ L$

Conclusions: I.  $M @ L$     II.  $L * R$     III.  $L \% M$

- (c) Only II and III are true
- (d) All I, II and III are true
- (e) None of these

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Q13. Statements:  $C © D * F, G \% F \$ L$

Conclusions: I.  $W * T$     II.  $X © W$     III.  $X * T$


