Interest rates are incredibly (B)/ low right now and it had (C)/a lot of people thinking about refinancing (D) any consumer debt they have (A)

S2. Ans. (b)

Sol. The correct arrangement of the parts of statement (III) is **CABD**. Part (C) contains error in it. “**center**” will be replaced by “**centers**”. Hence, **option (b)** is the right answer choice. Day care center in this country (C)/have been serving tens of thousands (A)/ of children of front-line workers (B)/without triggering clusters of cases (D)

S3. Ans. (d)

Sol. The correct arrangement of the parts of statement (V) is **DBAC**. Part A contains error in it. “**shoulder**” should be replaced with “**shouldering**”. Hence, **option (d)** is the right answer choice.
