When a word and number arrangement machine is given an input line of words and numbers, it arranges them following a particular rule. The following is an illustration of input and its rearrangement. (All the numbers are two-digit numbers.)

Input: dearing 18 integrity 50 denon 89 bore 33 century 81 23 bust.

Step I: bore dearing 18 integrity 50 denon 33 century 81 23 bust 89

Step II: bore bust dearing 18 integrity 50 denon 33 century 23 81 89

Step III: bore bust denon dearing 18 integrity 33 century 23 50 81 89

Step IV: bore bust denon century dearing 18 integrity 23 33 50 81 89

Step V: bore bust denon century dearing integrity 18 23 33 50 81 89

Step V is the last step of the above arrangement as the intended arrangement is obtained. As per the rules followed in the above steps, find out the appropriate steps for the given input.

The ground floor of the building is numbered 1, the floor above it 2 and so on until the topmost floor is numbered 7. Each person likes different colours – Blue, Black, White, Red, Pink, Purple, Grey, but not necessarily in the same order.

P doesn't like black color and live above S. The one who likes purple colour lives on even numbered floor below floor numbered 6. S who likes white live on odd numbered floor below the floor who likes purple colour. V lives on 6th floor. The one who likes blue color lives on floor number 5. Same number of person lives above and below Q. R lives immediate above the one who likes grey color. T lives immediate below the one who likes grey color. Two person lives between T and U. P lives immediate below the one who likes Red color.



The words are rearranged in increasing order of their length and in case of a tie, they are arranged according to the dictionary, from left to right. Numbers are rearranged in descending order from right to left. Each step arranges a word and a number.

Input: 19 numerology 48 global 88 cried 25 telling 79 59 fabricate torcher

Step I: - Cried 19 numerology 48 global 25 telling 79 59 fabricate torcher 88

Step II: - Cried global 19 numerology 48 25 telling 59 fabricate torcher 79 88

Step III: - Cried global telling 19 numerology 48 25 fabricate torcher 59 79 88

Step IV: - Cried global telling torcher 19 numerology 25 fabricate 48 59 79 88

Step V: - Cried global telling torcher fabricate 19 numerology 25 48 59 79 88

Step VI: - Cried global telling torcher fabricate numerology 19 25 48 59 79 88



- The number at the end of the code is the place value of the last letter in the given word according to alphabetical order.
