Conclusions:

Only speed is wages

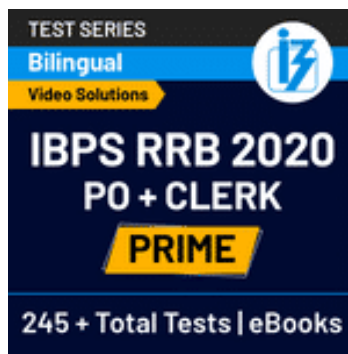
