Give answer

- (a) If only conclusion I follows.
- (b) If only conclusion II follows.
- (c) If either conclusion I or II follows.
- (d) If neither conclusion I nor II follows.
- (e) If both conclusions I and II follow.

Q1. Statements:

Only a few March are April.

Only a few April is May.

All May is June.

Conclusions:

I. All June being April is a possibility.

II. Some May are March.

Q2. Statements:

Only chips are coffee.

Some chips is cookies.

Only a few cookies is sugar.

Conclusions:

I. Some coffee is cookies

II. All cookies are sugar is a possibility

Q3. Statements:

Some Blue are Olive.

All Olive is Yellow.

Some Yellow is White.

Conclusions:

I. Some Olive is White.

II. Some Blue are Yellow.

(e) None of these

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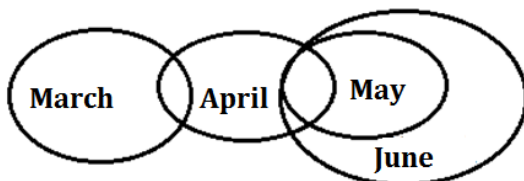
