# India Independence Day 2020: PM Narendra Modi Speech

Prime Minister Narendra Modi unfurled the national flag and delivered his seventh consecutive Independence Day speech from the iconic Red Fort. In the 1 hour 26-minute speech, he focused on the themes of "Aatma Nirbhar Bharat (self-reliant India)", "Vocal for local" and "Make in India to Make for World".

In his address to the nation on the occasion of India's 74th Independence Day, Prime Minister Narendra Modi applauded frontline workers fighting against novel coronavirus. PM Modi highlighted the importance to make India self-reliant, saying it was not just a word but should be a "mantra" for all countrymen. The Independence Day ceremony at the Red Fort was attended by over 4,000 people, including diplomats, officials and media personnel. Safety protocols were in place for the event, including social distancing and wearing masks.

### 21 Gun Salute:

The unfurling of the tri-colour is synchronised with the 21 Gun Salute fired by the gunners of the elite 2233 Field Battery (Ceremonial). Major Shweta Pandey assisted the PM in unfurling the National Flag. The ceremonial battery is being commanded by Lt Col Jitendra Singh Mehta and the Gun Position Officer is Naib Subedar (AIG), Anil Chand. The PM also received the Guard of Honour contingent, consisting of one officer and 24 men each from the Army, Navy, Air Force and Delhi Police.

#### **Key highlights on PM's speech:**

- The Prime Minister winds up his speech with chants of Bharat Mata ki Jai, Vande Mataram, Jai Hind!
- PM Narendra Modi announces the launch of the **National Digital Health Mission**, under which all Indian would get a **unique health ID**. Every Indian will be given a health ID which will contain all your information. What disease you suffer from, which doctor has been consulted, what medicines you are on will all be included in your health ID.

- **Optical fibre network** to be extended to all villages. In the last 5 years, 1.5 Lakh village panchayats have been connected with optical fibre. Within the next 1000 days, India will take optical fibre to 6 lakh villages.
- India is one of the top 5 nations in renewable energy. India is working to decrease pollution in the country. India is manufacturing 2000 crore ethanol, which will benefit the entire country.
- PM Modi announced that the centre has set up a committee to reconsider the minimum age for marriage of girls.
- India to focus on the two types of dolphins in Indian rivers, under **Project Dolphin**.
- India to develop Ladakh into the carbon-neutral state, just like Sikkim.
- India to focus on neighbourhood first. **ASEAN** also a part of India's focus.
- Coastal Infrastructure is important for the security of the nation. Andaman and Nicobar Islands provided with high-speed internet. In the next 1000 days, Lakshadweep will also be connected with high-speed internet.
- The Prime Minister further highlighted the role of women empowerment and spoke about the initiatives taken by the government to give further impetus to the growth of India's women. He highlighted how now women have the opportunity to get a permanent employment in the **Indian Army and Indian Navy**.





- The Prime Minister spoke one year of revoking of **Article 370.** He stated that this one year has paved the way for a new journey of development for Jammu and Kashmir.
- Under 'Jal Jeevan Mission', India has been able to provide clean water to over 2 crore families, especially in far-flung areas.
- Agriculture Infrastructure Fund was created to provide modern infrastructure to the farmers. The fund is worth **Rs 1 lakh crore.**
- With the identification of 110 aspirational districts, special efforts are being taken to ensure that people get access to better education, better health facilities and better employment opportunities.
- The Prime Minister highlighted the importance of education in working towards created an 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat'. He highlighted that the newly launched New Education Policy, which has been launched after almost 3 decades, will make Indian students global citizens.
- India has broken all its past FDI records. India saw
   18 per cent jump in FDI even during a pandemic.
- India is developing three COVID-19 vaccines, which are currently under trials. The Prime Minister assured that he will ensure that the vaccines reach everyone once they get all the required approval.

# Cabinet approves setting up o f National Recruitment Agency

The establishment of "National Recruitment Agency" has received the Union Cabinet's approval. The National Recruitment Agency (NRA) will result in transformational reform in the recruitment process for central government jobs. NRA will comprise of representatives of Ministry of Railways, Ministry of Finance/Department of Financial Services, the SSC, RRB as well as IBPS. NRA is expected to be a specialist body which will offer the state-of-the-art technology and best practices to the field of Central Government recruitment. A sum of Rs. 1517.57 crore has been sanctioned by the Government of India for the National Recruitment Agency (NRA).

The National Recruitment Agency (NRA) would be a multi-agency body which be responsible to conduct a Common Eligibility Test (CET). Some important features of CET:

- The **CET** will be conducted to shortlist candidates for the **Group B and C (non-technical) posts.**
- The scores received by the candidate in CET shall be valid for a period of **3-years** from the date of declaration of the result.
- There shall be no restriction on the number of attempts to be taken by a candidate to appear in the Common Eligibility Test subject to the upper age limit.
- Separate CET each for the three levels of matriculate (10th pass), higher secondary (12th pass) and the graduated candidates.
- Based on the screening done at the CET score level, the final selection for recruitment shall be made via separate specialised **Tiers (II, III etc)** of examination which shall be conducted by the respective recruitment agency.
- Candidates will be able to reap the advantage of registering on a common portal and give a choice of Centres.
- CET would be available in a number of languages.
- CET is expected to significantly reduce the recruitment cycle.

### IIT Madras Tops Atal Rankings (ARIIA) 2020

The Indian Institute of Technology, Madras has retained the top position in the 'Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements,' (ARIIA) 2020 for being the best centrally funded institution in India. The 2020 'Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA),' was released by Vice President Venkaiah Naidu, in presence of Union Minister of Education, Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank,' in a virtual event on 18 August 2020.

### Swachh Survekshan Awards 2020 Announced

**Swachh Survekshan 2020** awards have been announced and **Indore** became India's cleanest city for the fourth year in a row. Union Minister Hardeep Singh Puri announced the Swachh Survekshan 2020 result at

the Award Ceremony **'Swachh Mahotsav'** in the national capital being organised by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoUHA). This is the fifth edition of the annual cleanliness survey of the country. A total of 129 awards will be handed out to the topperforming cities and states.

Swachh Survekshan was started by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2016. While **Mysuru** won the award for the cleanest city of India in 2016, Indore retained the top spot for three consecutive years in **2017**, **2018 and 2019**. One city has been given only one Award. ### **National Affairs**

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has announced the "One Sun, One World, One Grid" (OSOWOG) plan. Under this, there will be a trans-national electricity grid, for supplying solar power across the globe.
- A campaign on "Ayush for Immunity" has been launched by the Ministry of AYUSH. The campaign was rolled out during a webinar which featured the participation of More than 50 thousand people. The webinar was streamed by the Ministry of AYUSH on its new digital communication platform Ayush Virtual Convention Centre (AVCC).
- Ministry of Tribal Affairs has launched the Tribal Health and Nutrition Portal "Swasthya" and enewsletter on health and nutrition "ALEKH". The ministry has also announced the opening of National Overseas Portal and National Tribal Fellowship Portal.
- An "Innovation Challenge Fund" of £3 Million has been launched by the government of United Kingdom (UK) in India. The newly launched fund aims to support research and development (R&D) proposals to address the challenges posed to the economy and the environment, by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Drone based surveillance system has been introduced by the Indian Railways for Railway security. The Railway Protection Force (RPF) has decided to employ large number of drones for the purpose of Railway security.

 Ministry of Tribal Affairs has signed a joint communication with Ministry of Rural Development to promote sustainable livelihood opportunities. Through the joint communication, both ministries will together promote sustainable livelihood opportunities among tribal women Self Help Groups (SHGs) under National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM).

#### States in the News

- Chief Minister of Nagaland, Neiphiu Rio has launched "Yellow Chain" a centralized ecommerce system to provide the people of the state integrated platform to build sustainable businesses either in products or services from their own locations for sustainable economic activity.
- Chhattisgarh government has announced to launch a student centric scheme named as "Padhai Tuhar Para". The scheme will enable the school students to study with the help of community in their localities and villages, in view of the suspension of classes due to coronavirus outbreak.
- Quality Control Lab has been set up by the Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA) in Porbandar, Gujarat. The Quality Control Lab will offer tests for seafood processors as well as exporters to confirm to product safety as per international regulatory requirements.
- The tertiary processing centres of "Trifood Project" of TRIFED, Ministry of Tribal Affairs has been virtually launched by the Union Tribal Affairs Minister Arjun Munda. The Trifood project has been launched in Raigad, Maharashtra and Jagdalpur, Chhattisgarh. This project is expected to help in encouraging the tribal entrepreneurship.
- The Chhatarpur Police of Madhya Pradesh has been running a campaign "Ek Sankalp-Bujurgo ke naam" in the midst of corona infection in the state. "Ek Sankalp-Bujurgo ke naam" i.e. 'a commitment for elders' is proving to be a boon for the elderly and helpless people living alone in homes during the global pandemic COVID-19.

### **International Affairs**

- Malian President, Ibrahim Boubacar Keita has resigned and dissolved parliament hours after mutinying soldiers detained him at gunpoint, plunging a country already facing an insurgency and mass protests deeper into crisis.
- Luis Rodolfo Abinader Corona has been sworn in as the 54th President of Dominican Republic. He succeeds Danilo Medina of Liberation Party.
- Keith Rowley sworn in as Prime Minister of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago for a 2nd consecutive 5-year term. He is from the ruling People's National Movement (PNM).
- Francisco Pascual Eyegue Obama Asue was reappointed as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Equatorial Guinea for 3rd consecutive term.

### Agreements/MoUs Signed

- An Memorandum of understanding (MoU) has been signed by India's homegrown ecommerce player "Flipkart" with Indian Institutes of Technology (IIT) Patna. The MoU will encourage industry focused applied research in the areas of Artificial Intelligence (AI), Natural Language Processing (NLP) and Machine Learning (ML).
- Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), NITI Aayog and Business Sweden on behalf of India Sweden Healthcare Innovation Centre has signed a virtual Statement of Intent (SoI) to expand the culture of innovation in the country.
- Ministry of Skill Development has inked an MoU with Ministry of Shipping to promote skill development in port and maritime sector. The partnership between the two ministries seeks to skill, re-skill and up-skill the manpower for the growing maritime industry as well as development of coastal community.
- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed by the Indian Institute of Management Kozhikode (IIM-K) with the Switzerland-based HELP Logistics.
- Uttar Pradesh government has signed a 'plan of cooperation' with Israel government to resolve water crisis in Bundelkhand region.
