# RBI releases revised Priority Sector Lending Guidelines

- The **Priority Sector Lending** (PSL) **Guidelines** have been reviewed by the **Reserve Bank of India** to align the PSL Guidelines with evolving national priorities.
- The new guidelines will make better credit penetration into credit deficient areas and increase the lending to small as well as marginal farmers and weaker sections. It will also enhance credit to renewable energy, and health infrastructure.
- In the revised PSL Guidelines, the Reserve Bank of India has included some fresh categories eligible for finance under priority sector.
- These include loans to farmers for installation of solar power plants; loans for establishment of Compressed Bio Gas (CBG) plants; and bank finance to start-ups of up to Rs 50 crore.

Some key features of **revised PSL guidelines** are as follows:

- To address the issue of regional disparities in the flow of priority sector credit, RBI has assigned higher weightage to incremental priority sector credit in 'identified districts' where priority sector credit flow is relatively low.
- The targets stipulated for "small and marginal farmers" as well as "weaker sections" are being increased in a phased manner.
- Credit limit has been raised for the Farmers Producers Organisations (FPOs)/Farmers Producers Companies (FPCs) undertaking farming with assured marketing of their produce at a pre-determined price.
- The loan limits for renewable energy have been doubled.
- The credit limit for health infrastructure (including those under 'Ayushman Bharat') has been doubled to improve the health infrastructure.



# Ministry of Home Affairs issues Guidelines for "Unlock 4"

**Ministry of Home Affairs** has issued **"Unlock 4"** guidelines for the phased re-opening of activities in areas outside the Containment Zones. The "Unlock 4" guidelines will be effective from **September 1, 2020.** 

## Key features of the "Unlock 4" guidelines are as follows:

- According to the new guidelines, Metro rail will be permitted to operate with effect from 7th September 2020 in a graded manner.
- New guidelines permits the Social/ academic/ sports/ entertainment/ cultural/ religious/ political functions and other congregations with a ceiling of 100 persons, with effect from 21st September 2020. All the above gatherings will have to follow mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing, provision for thermal scanning and hand wash or sanitizer.
- It also allows the opening of Open air theatres with effect from 21st September 2020.
- No restrictions will be there on Inter-State and intra-State movement.
- The Schools, colleges, educational and coaching institutions will continue to remain closed for students and regular class activity up to 30th September 2020. Although, Students of classes 9 to 12 may be permitted to visit their schools, in areas outside the Containment Zones only, on voluntary basis, with effect from 21st September 2020.
- Cinema halls, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres (excluding open air theatre) and similar places will continue to remain closed.
- Lockdown shall is stated to be implemented strictly in the Containment Zones till 30th September, 2020.
- Department of Higher Education (DHE) will permit the Higher Education Institutions only for research scholars (Ph.D.) and post-graduate students of technical and professional programmes requiring laboratory/ experimental works, in consultation with Ministry of Home Affairs.

### **Government of India Blocks 118 Mobile Apps**

- Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India has decided to block 118 mobile apps in view of the emergent nature of threats.
- These applications have been blocked as there was information that these apps are engaged in activities which is prejudicial to sovereignty and integrity of India, defence of India, security of state as well as public order.



• 118 mobile apps have been blocked by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology by invoking it's power under section 69A of the Information Technology Act read with the relevant provisions of the Information Technology (Procedure and Safeguards for Blocking of Access of Information by Public) Rules 2009.

# Union Cabinet approves "Mission Karmayogi" NPCSCB

- Union Cabinet has approved the launch of a "Mission Karmayogi" National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building (NPCSCB).
- A sum of **Rs. 510.86 crore** will be spent over a period of 5 years from 2020-21 to 2024-25 in order to cover around 46 lakh Central employees.
- Mission Karmayogi has been launched to prepare the Indian Civil Servant for the future by making him more creative, constructive, imaginative, innovative, proactive, professional, progressive, energetic, enabling, transparent and technology-enabled.
- An Integrated Government Online Training "iGOTKarmayogiPlatform" would be set up to deliver the programme.

The National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building (NPCSCB) will be launched with the following institutional framework:

- Prime Minister's Public Human Resources (HR) Council
- Capacity Building Commission
- Special Purpose Vehicle for owning and operating the digital assets and the technological platform for online training
- Coordination Unit headed by the Cabinet Secretary

# India ranks 48th in Global Innovation Index 2020

- India has joined the group of top 50 countries in the global innovation index for the first time, moving up four places to the 48th rank and keeping the top position among the nations in central and southern Asia.
- India ranks in the top 15 in indicators such as ICT (Information and Communication Technology) services exports, government online services, graduates in science and engineering, and R&Dintensive global companies.
- The 13th edition of the Global Innovation Index (GII) 2020 has jointly released by the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), Cornell University and INSEAD Business School.

- Government of Dubai Authority on commodities trade and enterprise, Dubai Multi Commodities Centre (DMCC) has rolled out a technology-driven agricommodity trading and sourcing platform "Agriota E-Marketplace". It will help in bridging the gap between millions of rural farmers in India and the UAE's food industry.
- India will receive an **Official Development Assistance** (ODA) loan of an amount of JPY50 billion (approx. **Rs. 3,500 crore**) from the government of Japan as the COVID-19 Crisis Emergency Response Support in order to fight the COVID-19 crisis.
- Japanese government has committed Grant Assistance of an amount of JPY 1 billion (approx. Rs. 70 crore) for offering medical equipment to bolster the public health and medical system in India.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has announced to celebrate September 2020 as "Poshan Maah" or "Nutrition Month". He also stataed that the schools must introduce Nutrition Monitor and Nutrition Cards to increase the awareness of nutrition among the children.
- Union Department of Fertilizers is observing Swachhta Pakhwada from 1st to 15th September 2020
- Union Territories Ladakh & Lakshadweep have been included in the 'One Nation-One Ration Card' scheme on 'Integrated Management of Public Distribution System' (IM-PDS). With this a total of 26 States /UTs Connected with the Scheme and will benefit about 65 crore people.
- Minister of State (MoS) (I/C) for **Power and New & Renewable Energy**, Raj Kumar Singh launched the Pan-India "Green Term Ahead Market (GTAM)" in New Delhi virtually, for electricity. **GTAM** is the World's First Exclusive Product Market for the renewable energy sector.
- National Nutrition Week is observed every year from 1st September to 7th September since 1982.

- The first-ever "**seaplane services in Gujarat**" will be commenced from 31 October 2020. It will offer seamless and affordable air connectivity from Sabarmati Riverfront in **Ahmedabad** to Statue of Unity in **Kevadia** in **Gujarat**.
- "Major Dhyan Chand Vijaypath Yojana" has been launched by the Uttar Pradesh government. Under this scheme, 19 international players from the state of Uttar Pradesh will get road connectivity to their houses.
- **Kerala** will establish the first international women's trade centre (IWTC) of India at Angamaly. The IWTC would be set by Kerala in consonance with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- **Madhya Pradesh** government has launched a 15-day campaign named 'Gandagi Bharat Chhodo'.
- Punjab government has rolled out "I Rakhwali" App to ensure greenery and to protect the environment in Punjab.

- **ICICI Bank** has launched a virtual property exhibition under the name 'Home Utsav' which will digitally showcase real estate projects by renowned developers, across India.
- Estimates of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the first quarter (April-June) Q1 of 2020-21 has been released by the National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry Statistics and Programme Implementation. According to the latest release, the GDP at Constant (2011-12) Prices in Q1 of 2020-21 is estimated at Rs 26.90 lakh crore and the Indian economy has experienced a contraction of 23.9% as compared to 5.2% growth in Q1 2019-20.
