S1.Ans.(d) Sol. 'affected, scale' fits the sentence appropriately. S2.Ans.(a) Sol. 'conscious, keep' fits the sentence appropriately. S3.Ans.(e) Sol. 'argued, control' fits the sentence appropriately. S4.Ans.(c) Sol. 'spanning, adieu' fits the sentence appropriately where 'spanning' means to extend across (a period of time or a range of subjects) and 'adieu' means goodbye. S5.Ans.(b) Sol. 'With, garrisoned' fits the sentence appropriately where 'garrisoned' means a group of troops stationed in a fortress or town to defend it. S6. Ans.(d)
Sol. 'While' here indicates that something opposite follows. So, while war has never been entirely absent, there have been some periods that appear remarkably peaceful. Hence, 'serene' or 'pacific might suit the second blank. But serene is coupled with 'posterity', which means 'future generations and so does not fit.

S7. Ans. (d)

Sol. Option A is incorrect because 'watching' is not followed by 'to'.

Sol. 'despite' indicates something contrary. So, despite the rejection slips he pursues his path doggedly or tirelessly. But since the 'and' links similar things he is getting disappointment along with the rejection slips, not encouragement.

S9. Ans.(a)

Sol. The part after the semicolon expands upon the first part of the sentence.

So, since the first part tells us that there is no money in archaeology, then there will only be small (paltry) amounts for excavating. Also 'even more' indicates that another similar word is required. Thus, meager also means small.

S10.Ans. (a)

Sol. Here is the task is to determine the communal reaction to crime. The writer maintains that the criminal justice system of punishments allows the community to purge itself of its anger, its sense of outrage at the criminal's acts. Thus, it provides a catharsis or purgation for the community.

Remember in double blank sentences, go through the answers, testing the first word in each choice and eliminating those that do not fit. In this case you can readily eliminate.

Choices B and D: it is unlikely that an essential purpose of the criminal justice system would be the provision of either a disclaimer (denial or disavowal, as in disavowing responsibility for a legal claim) or a document.
