The one who likes Yellow faces the one who sits immediate right of Q. One person sits between Q and R who likes Orange. The one who sits immediate right of R faces the one who likes white. D does not like Red. There are two people sit between the one who likes white and the one who likes Green. P sits immediate left of S and faces C. The one who likes Red faces the one who likes Pink and the one who likes pink sits immediate left of the one who likes Black. B faces the one who likes grey but does not sit at any extreme end. D sits 2<sup>nd</sup> left of E. S does not like Brown.

Directions (11-15): Study the information carefully and answer the questions given below.

Eight persons J, K, L, M, N, O, P and Q were born in different months of the same year. These months are January, February, March, June, July, September, October and December. They live on different floor of eight storey building (not necessarily in the same order). The ground floor is numbered as first, the floor just above it is numbered as second and so on till top floor which is numbered as eighth.

Only one floor between L and the one who born in February. O was born in a month which has 30 days. The one who was born in February live on one of the odd numbered floor above 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. No one live between J and the one who was born in September. L was born in the month which has 30 days but not in September. L lives below the one who was born in February but not on 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. J does not live on 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> floor. There is a gap of 3 floors between the one who was born in June and the one who was born in December. N lives immediately below the top floor. The one who was born in March live just below the one who was born in February. Q lives immediately above P. There is one floor between the one which was born in January and the one who was born in March but the one who was born in January does not live on 4<sup>th</sup> floor. K lives just below N. The one who was born in October lives below O. J lives above the one who was born in September.

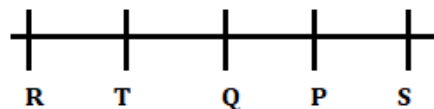
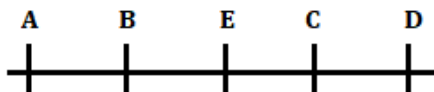

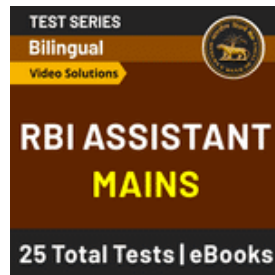
