Seven boxes are placed one above another. Each box contains different numbers of flower i.e. 14, 17, 40, 25, 32, 9 and 16.

There are three boxes are placed between box A and the one which contain maximum number of flowers. More than four boxes are placed above box C. Box E does not contain maximum number of flowers. G contain number of flowers which is perfect square of even number. Number of boxes between G and D is half of number of boxes between G and C which contain number of flowers which is perfect square of an odd number. Difference between numbers of flowers is 5 in box D and F which is placed just below D. Box E placed below B. Box A contain 15 flowers more than E. Box B placed below box A.

Nine persons M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T and U are sitting in a linear row and all of them face towards south. Each of them likes different Colours i.e. Red, Blue, Green, Pink, Purple, White, Black, Brown and Yellow.

Four persons sit between R and O, who likes Brown. O does not sit at extreme end of the row. The one who likes pink colour sits third to the left of one who sits second to the right of R. N sits third to the right of M, who likes purple. N sits third to the left of Q. S sits immediate right of the one who likes Black. Two persons sit between T and the one who likes Blue colour. T is not immediate neighbor of R. U sits third to the right of the one who likes Pink colour. The one who likes White colour is immediate neighbor of the one who likes Green colour. Q is not immediate neighbor of O. S likes blue colour. More than five persons sit between the one who likes red colour and the one who likes white colour.

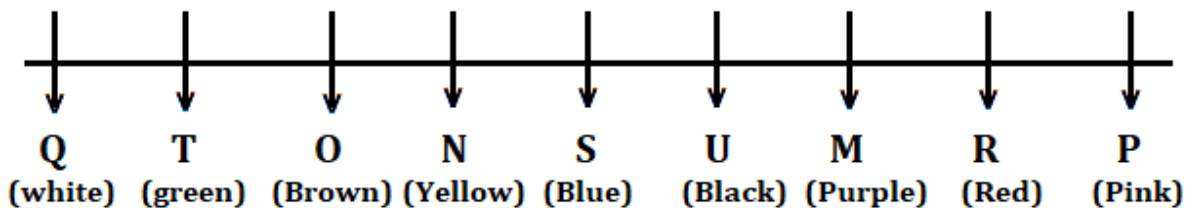

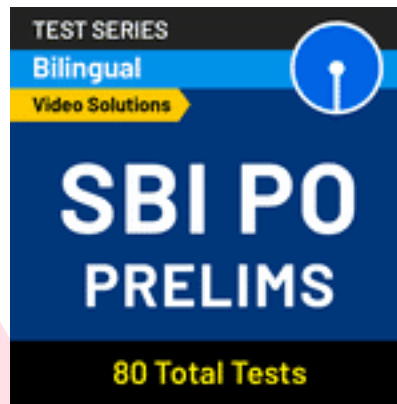
