Significantly, in **remarking (1)** who a whistle-blower is, the law goes beyond government officials who **boost (2)** corruption they come across in the course of their work. It includes any other person or non-governmental organisation. The importance of such **radical (3)** expansion is underlined by the fact that in the last few years, more than 65 people have been killed for exposing corruption in the government on the basis of **instruction (4)** they obtained under the Right to Information (RTI) Act. The RTI law has **guarantee (5)** the common man to have access to information from public authorities — which only government officials were earlier **privy (6)** to — making every citizen a **potential (7)** whistle-blower.

The WBP law has provisions for **involving (8)** the identity of a whistle-blower, if so desired, following cases such as Satyendra K. Dubey's, whose murder in 2003 led to demand for such legislation. In a letter addressed to the Prime Minister, Dubey, a manager in the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) posted at Gaya, had highlighted corrupt practices in the NHAI and **jointly (9)** requested that his identity be kept secret. But the information was **lost (10)**, leading to his murder.

S1. Ans. (c)

Sol. "defining" is the correct word replacement as it means state or describe exactly the nature, scope, or meaning of. Here, defining is used to describe a whistle-blower. Other options do not fit into sentence in context of their meanings.

S2. Ans. (d)

Sol. "expose" is the correct word replacement as it means make (something) visible by uncovering it. It is to be noted that the verb it requires should be plural as the Subject it denotes is Plural (government officials). Hence based on Subject-Verb agreement and its meaning, option (d) is the correct choice.

S3. Ans. (a)

Sol. "progressive" is the correct word replacement as it means happening or developing gradually or in stages. The phrase "progressive expansion" adds meaning to the paragraph. Hence option (a) is the correct choice.

S4. Ans. (b)

Sol. "information" is the correct word replacement as it means what is conveyed or represented by a particular arrangement or sequence of things. Options (a), (c) and (d) can be easily eliminated as they can't be obtained under RTI Act. Hence "on the basis of information they obtained under the Right to Information (RTI) Act" makes a good choice.

S5. Ans. (d)

Sol. "empowered" is the correct word replacement as it means make (someone) stronger and more confident, especially in controlling their life and claiming their rights. Other options are neglected on the basis of their usage.

S6. Ans. (e)

Sol. "privy" is the correct word in context of its usage in the sentence as it means sharing in the knowledge of (something secret or private). Hence (e) is the correct option.

S7. Ans. (e)

Sol. "potential" is the correct word in context of its usage in the sentence as it means having or showing the capacity to develop into something in the future. The phrase "making every citizen a potential whistle-blower" adds meaning to the sentence. Hence (e) is the correct choice.

S8. Ans. (b)

Sol. "concealing" is the correct word replacement as it means preventing (something) from being known; keep secret. "concealing the identity" makes an appropriate phrase and adds meaning to the sentence. Hence (b) is the correct choice.

S9. Ans. (c)

Sol. "specifically" is the correct word replacement as it means in a way that is exact and clear; precisely. "specifically requested" makes the sentence complete and meaningful. Hence (c) is the correct choice. S10. Ans. (a)

Sol. "leaked" is the correct word replacement as it means intentionally disclosed (secret information). "the information was leaked" is the correct phrase to add meaning to the paragraph. Hence (a) is the correct choice.

S11. Ans. (a)

Sol. "is testimony to the fact that" is the correct phrase that makes the sentence grammatically correct. Considering options, options (b), (c) and (d) are not correctly matched with the grammar usage. They do not add correct meaning to the sentence. The word 'testimony' means "evidence or proof of something" and thus "testimony to the fact" makes the right syntax. Hence (a) is the correct option. S12. Ans. (b)

Sol. "took over as the" is the correct phrase to make the sentence grammatically correct. Read the sentence carefully, later part of the sentence suggests that "took over" is the correct phrasal verb to add meaning to the sentence. The phrasal verb "take over" means an act of assuming control of something. Hence (b) is the correct option.

S13. Ans. (d)

Sol. "that has been crafted" is the correct phrase to make the sentence grammatically correct. It is to be noted that the sentence is in Passive form. Moreover the preposition "by" is correct usage as it signifies the action performed by distinguished brains in America's science fraternity. Hence (d) is the correct option.

S14. Ans. (b)

Sol. "than the others" is the correct phrase to make the sentence grammatically correct. It is to be noted that the sentence is in comparative form as can be seen with the phrase "more frequently". Thus the use of "than" is required to match the correct syntax. Hence (b) is the correct option.

S15. Ans. (e)

Sol. "as to what sort of" is the correct phrase in context of its meaning and structure to the sentence. Hence it doesn't require any correction; (e) is the correct option.
