- The following details are being shared as advance information to provide sufficient time to the candidates to prepare themselves for the Computer-based Written Test and Physical Screening Test (PST).

*** DATE OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION: FROM AUGUST 17-31, 2021**

- The Computer-Based Test (CBT) consisting of two papers of 2 hours duration each will comprise of 100 Multiple Choice Questions for each paper with four marks awarded for every correct answer.
- Negative marking for each incorrect answer shall be to the extent of 25% of the marks assigned to a question

IMPORTANT NOTE

- Written Based Test will be conducted before the Physical Screening Test (PST).
- Only candidates who clear the Written Test will be eligible for the Physical Screening Test (PST), which will be qualifying in nature. No marks will be awarded for the PST, but all candidates must clear the prescribed fitness trial events.
- Merit will be drawn up purely on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the Computer Based Written Examination.

* Date of Computer-Based Written Tests subject to change in case of unforeseen circumstances/reasons.

Disclaimer:

This information is being shared with the candidates regarding eligibility, physical standards/screening for the recruitment & test syllabus. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

AGE

As on 1st January 2021, a candidate should have attained the age of 18 years but should not have attained the age of 28 years, provided further that:

- SC/ST/BC candidates shall be given relaxation in upper age limit by 5 years.*
- Ex-Servicemen shall be given relaxation in the upper age limit by 3 years, plus the number of years of service, rendered/served by them in the Indian Defence Forces.*
- Serving government employees (State Govt. or Central Govt.) shall be given relaxation in upper age limit by 5 years, but they should not have attained the age of 33 years, as on 1st January 2021.*

S. No.	Name of the Post	Minimum Educational Qualifications
1	Sub Inspector (District Police Cadre)	Candidate should be a graduate from a recognized university, or its equivalent
2	Sub Inspector (Armed Police Cadre)	Candidate should be a graduate from a recognized university, or its equivalent
3	Sub Inspector (Investigation Cadre)	Candidate should be a graduate from a recognized university, or its equivalent
4	Intelligence Officer (in the rank of Sub Inspector, Intelligence Cadre)	Candidate should be: a) A graduate from a recognized University or Institution, as the case may be, provided that such candidate shall also possess an 'O' Level Certificate of Information Technology from National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) (earlier called as DOEACC); OR b) A Graduate from a recognized University or Institution with Computer Science, or Computer Applications: or Information Technology as one of the elective subjects during the entire duration of graduation; OR c) B.Sc/B.Tech/B.E in Information Technology, or Computer Science; or Computer Engineering or Computer Science & Engineering; or Information Systems; or Computer Networking; or Data Science; or Software Engineering; or BCA; or Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications from a recognized University or Institution, as the case may be.

For Male Candidates (excluding Ex-Servicemen)	(a) 1600 meters RUN to be completed in 7 minutes (only one chance).
	(b) Long Jump 3.65 meters (3 chances).
	(c) High Jump 1.10 meters (3 chances).
For Female Candidates	(a) 800 meters RUN to be completed in 5 minutes (only one chance).
	(b) Long Jump 3 meters (3 chances).
	(c) High Jump 0.90 meters (3 chances).
For Ex-Servicemen Male Candidates of age up to and including 35 years	(a) 1400 meters WALK & RUN to be completed in 9 minutes (only one chance).
	(b) 10 Sit-ups within 2 minutes
For Ex-Servicemen Male Candidates of age more than 35 years	(a) 1400 meters WALK & RUN to be completed in 12 minutes (only one chance).
	(b) 10 Sit-ups within 3 minutes.

For Female Candidates	(a) 400 meters RUN to be completed in 2 minutes (only one chance).
	(b) Long Jump 6 Feet (3 chances).

For Ex-Servicemen Male Candidates (35 years and above)	(a) 800 meters WALK & RUN to be completed in 6 minutes (only one chance).
