Sol. Hindi Diwas or Hindi Day is observed every year on 14 September to mark the popularity of Hindi as an official language of India. The language was adopted under Article 343 of the Indian Constitution. The first Hindi day was celebrated on 14th September 1953.

S2. Ans.(a)

Sol. In Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel has announced the launch of 'Millet Mission', which aims to provide proper price rate to farmers for minor cereal crops.

S3. Ans.(c)

Sol. India and the United States of America (USA) have launched the "Climate Action and Finance Mobilization Dialogue (CAFMD)". It will strengthen India-US bilateral cooperation on climate and environment.
