1. **Spite (noun)**

Meaning; Ill will or hatred toward another



Synonyms: animosity, hate

Antonyms: kindness, love

2. **Truncate (verb)**

Meaning; To shorten (something) by, or as if by, cutting part of it off.



Synonyms: cut, trim

Antonyms: stretch, extend

3. **Jest (verb)**

Meaning; To tell a joke; to talk in a playful manner



Synonyms: mock, tease

Antonyms: compliment, commend

4. **Enthuse (verb)**
Meaning; to show enthusiasm



Synonyms: motivated, excited
Antonyms: demotivated, depressed

5. **Misprision (noun)**
Meaning; Criminal neglect of duty or wrongful execution of official duties



Synonyms: contempt
Antonyms: tolerance

6. **Vague (adjective)**
Meaning; Not clearly expressed



Synonyms: Blur, faint
Antonyms: certain, definit

7. **Meed (noun)**
Meaning; A payment or recompense made for services rendered or in recognition of some achievement



Synonyms: compensation
Antonyms: penalty
