

# **VOCABULARY**

## 1. Reprobate (noun)

Meaning; An individual with low morals or principles



Synonyms: Villian, Wretch Antonyms: virtuous, righteous

#### 2. Gaze (verb)

Meaning; To stare intently or earnestly.



Synonyms: stare, observe Antonyms: ignore, neglect

## Blitzkrieg (noun) 3.

Meaning; A fast, sudden military offensive, usually combining ground forces with air support.



Synonyms: bombardment, flurry Antonyms: protection, defence

#### Fret (verb) 4.

Meaning; To chafe or irritate; to worry.



Synonyms: concern, discomfort Antonyms: relax, comfort

# Gnaw (verb) **5.**

Meaning; To produce excessive anxiety or worry.



**Synonyms**: torture, trouble **Antonyms**: soothe, aid

## 6. Peevish (adjective)

Meaning; Easily annoyed, especially by things that are not important; irritable,



**Synonyms**: irritable Antonyms: affable

# 7. Evangelize (verb)

Meaning; To preach any ideology to those who have not yet been converted to it.



Synonyms: preach Antonyms: dissuade
