1. Approbation (noun)

Meaning; The act of approving



Synonyms: approval, assent Antonyms: rejection, refusal

Meaning; without the knowledge of



Synonyms: unknown, unaware

Inferno (noun) 3.

Meaning; A large fire, a conflagration.



Antonyms: known, aware

Synonyms: disordered, tumultuous Antonyms: ordered, disciplined

Frenetic (adjective) 4.


Meaning; Fast, harried; having extreme enthusiasm or energy.



Synonyms: hectic, wild Antonyms: tranquil, settled

5. Flux(noun)

Meaning; The act of flowing; a continuous moving on or passing by



Synonyms: flow, movement Antonyms: calm, stand

6. Shrift (noun)

Meaning; The act of going to or hearing a religious confession



Synonyms: acceptance, acknowledgement

Antonyms: conceal, hide

7. Connivance (verb)

Meaning; The process of conniving or conspiring.



Synonyms: indulge, conspire Antonyms: reject, disapprove
