

1. **Wrought (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Having been worked or prepared somehow.



**Synonyms:** fixed, specified

**Antonyms:** common, ordinary

2. **Clinch (verb)**

**Meaning;** To make certain; to finalize.



**Synonyms:** finalize, conclude

**Antonyms:** unsettle, release

3. **Exonerate (verb)**

**Meaning;** To relieve (someone or something) of a load; to unburden (a load).



**Synonyms:** absolve, acquit

**Antonyms:** charge, convict

**4. Splinter (verb)**

**Meaning;** To break, or cause to break, into factions.



**Synonyms:** split, fracture

**Antonyms:** join, combine

**5. Inflammatory (noun)**

**Meaning;** Tending to inflame or provoke somebody.



**Synonyms:** provocative

**Antonyms:** mitigating

**6. Subterranean (adjective)**

**Meaning;** below ground, under the earth, underground



**Synonyms:** subversive, covert

**Antonyms:** open, palpable

**7. Blatant (Adjective)**

**Meaning;** Bellowing; disagreeably clamorous; sounding loudly and harshly.



**Synonyms:** glaring

**Antonyms:** subtle
