1. **Buffet (verb)**

Meaning; To affect as with blows; to strike repeatedly; to strive with or contend against.



Synonyms: hit, strike

Antonyms: safeguard, Shield

Meaning; Misleading appearance; cover





Synonyms: semblance, appearance

Antonyms: reality, truth

Sedate (adjective) 3.


Meaning: Remaining composed and dignified, and avoiding too much activity or excitement.



Synonyms: calm, composed **Antonyms:** flustered, agitated

Mellow (adjective) 4.

Meaning; subdued, soft, rich, delicate



Synonyms: melodious, Mellifluent

Antonyms: harsh, gruff

5. Collapse (verb)

Meaning; To break apart



synonyms: fall, destroy **Antonyms**: build, construct

Denude (verb) 6.

Meaning; To divest



Synonyms: deprive, divest **Antonyms**: inherit, occupy

7. Plaudit (noun)

Meaning; A mark or expression of applause



Synonyms: commendation Antonyms: criticism
