1. Feverish (adjective)

Meaning; Filled with excess energy



Synonyms: excited, restless **Antonyms**: placid, tranquil

2. Bait (noun)

Meaning; Anything which allures; something used to lure or entice someone or something



Synonyms: lure

Antonyms: repulsion

3. Leverage (noun)

Meaning; By extension, any influence which is compounded or used to gain an advantage.



Synonyms: influence, dominance

Antonyms: impotence, powerlessness

4. Predatory (adjective)

Meaning; Exploiting or victimizing others for personal gain.



Synonyms: Greedy, exploitative Antonyms: Selfless, supportive

Cumbersome (adjective) 5.

Meaning; Burdensome or hindering, as a weight or drag; vexatious



Synonyms: complex, complicated

Antonyms: systematic, straightforward

Nightmare (noun) 6.

Meaning; Any bad, miserable, difficult or terrifying situation



Synonyms: dread, phobia

Antonyms: Gratifying, Pleasant

7. Listless (adjective)

Meaning; Lacking energy, enthusiasm, or liveliness



Synonyms: spiritless, lethargic

Antonyms: active, lively
