

# **VOCABULARY**

#### 1. Sidle (verb)

Meaning; To (cause something to) move sideways



Synonyms: sneak, slide Antonyms: march, ride

## Attune (verb) 2.

Meaning; to bring into harmony or accord.



Synonyms: harmonize, acclimatize Antonyms: disharnonize, destabilise

# 3. Meed (noun)

**Meaning**; achievement; reward, deserts; award.



Synonyms: award **Antonyms**: disregard

#### 4. conceive (verb)

Meaning; To develop an idea; to form in the mind; to plan; to devise; to originate



Synonyms: assume **Antonyms**: neglect

### Purge (noun) 5.

**Meaning**; A forcible removal of people, for example, from political activity.



**Synonyms:** expulsion, termination

**Antonyms:** keep, hold

## 6. Bout (noun)

**Meaning**; A period of something, usually painful or unpleasant



**Synonyms**: stretch **Antonyms**: stagnation

# Irrefutable (adjective) 7.

Meaning; undeniable; unable to be disproved or refuted



**Synonyms**: unquestionable **Antonyms**: questionable
