1. **Tenacious (Adjective)**

**Meaning;** Holding together; cohesive.



**Synonyms:** firm

**Antonyms:** loose

2. **Pillage (verb)**

**Meaning;** To loot or plunder by force



**Synonyms:** ransack, ravage

**Antonyms:** protect, defend

3. **Tizzy (noun)**

**Meaning;** A state of nervous excitement, confusion, or distress; a dither.



**Synonyms:** annoyance, acrimony

**Antonyms:** calmness, ease

4. **Agitate (verb)**

**Meaning;** To cause to move with a violent, irregular action



**Synonyms:** disturb, churn

**Antonyms:** calm, relax

5. **Reckon (verb)**

**Meaning;** To count; to enumerate; to number; also, to compute; to calculate.



**Synonyms:** estimate, consider

**Antonyms:** avoid, evade

6. **Contour (noun)**

**Meaning;** An outline, boundary or border, usually of curved shape.



**Synonyms:** outline

**Antonyms:** dullness

7. **Proclivity (noun)**

**Meaning;** A predisposition or natural inclination



**Synonyms:** like, affinity

**Antonyms:** dislike, hate
