Hoary (adjective) 1.

Meaning; Old or old-fashioned.



Synonyms: old, ancient **Antonyms:** new, modern

2. **Dormant** (adjective)

Meaning; Inactive, sleeping, asleep, suspended.



Synonyms: sleeping, slumbering

Antonyms: awake, active

3. Flout (verb)

Meaning; To express contempt for (laws, rules, etc.) by word or action.





Synonyms: defy, disregard **Antonyms:** honour, respect

4. Persistent (Adjective)

Meaning; Obstinately refusing to give up or let go.



Synonyms: firm, resolute Antonyms: weak, irresolute

Tenuous (adjective) 5.

Meaning; Thin in substance or consistency.



Synonyms: weak, fragile

Antonyms: strong, convincing

Listless (adjective) 6.

Meaning; Lacking energy, enthusiasm, or liveliness



Synonyms: spiritless, lethargic

Antonyms: active, lively

7. Alacritous (adjective)

Meaning; Brisk, speedy, with alacrity, quick and eager.



Synonyms: fast, speedy Antonyms: slow, lag
