1. Deplore (verb)

Meaning; To bewail; to weep bitterly over; to feel sorrow for.



Synonyms: lament, complain

Antonyms: commend, compliment

2. Abort (verb)

Meaning; To stop or fail at something in the preliminary stages.



Synonyms: halt, stop

Antonyms: begin, continue

3. Rubric (noun)

Meaning; An established rule or custom; a guideline



Synonyms: course

Antonyms: disperse

4. **Fret(verb)**

Meaning; To be anxious, to worry.



Synonyms: bother

Antonyms: comfort

5. **Traverse (verb)**

Meaning; To travel across, often under difficult conditions.



Synonyms: span, cross

Antonyms: hold, confine

6. **Oversight (noun)**

Meaning; An omission; something that is left out, missed or forgotten.



Synonyms; failure, lapse

Antonyms; careful, attention

7. **Kudos(noun)**

Meaning; Praise; accolades.



Synonyms: praise, applaud

Antonyms: dishonor, criticise
