


VOCABULARY

1. Subvert(verb)

Meaning; To overturn from the foundation; to overthrow;




Synonyms: topple, overturn

Antonyms: rectify, resolve

2. Emphatic (adjective)

Meaning; Characterized by emphasis; forceful



Synonyms: marked, pointed

Antonyms: unemphatic, unmarked

3. Flee (verb)

Meaning; To run away



Synonyms: leave, run

Antonyms: stay, continue

4. Demur (verb)

Meaning; To suspend judgment concerning; to doubt of or hesitate about



Synonyms: object, hesitate

Antonyms: confirm, agree

5. Imminent (adjective)

Meaning; about to happen, occur, or take place very soon




Synonyms: immediate, forthcoming

Antonyms: avoidable, escapable

6. Posit (verb)

Meaning; Propose for consideration or study; to suggest



Synonyms: postulate

Antonyms: forget

7. Buoyed (verb)

Meaning; To support or maintain at a high level.



Synonyms: cheer, boost

Antonyms: discourage, oppose
