**Synonyms:** disgraceful, shameful

**Antonyms:** respectful, appreciable

### 2. Churlishness (noun)

**Meaning;** the state of being rude, surly



**Synonyms:** rancor, antagonism

**Antonyms:** love, kindness

### 3. Exculpatory (adjective)

**Meaning;** tending to excuse or clear of wrongdoing.



**Synonyms:** defensible, pardonable

**Antonyms:** unforgivable, inexcusable

#### 4. Tortuous (adjective)

**Meaning;** Twisted; having many turns




**Synonyms:** curvy, winding

#### 5. Distil (verb)

**Meaning;** To extract the essence of; concentrate; purify.



**Synonyms:** extract, squeeze

**Antonyms:** conceal, hide
