

VOCABULARY

1. Inchoate (adjective)

Meaning; Recently started but not fully formed yet; just begun



Synonyms: nascent, budding **Antonyms:** evolved, developed

2. Shrift (noun)

Meaning; The act of going to or hearing a religious confession



Synonyms: acceptance, acknowledgement

Antonyms: conceal, hide

3. Rubric (noun)

Meaning; An established rule or custom; a guideline



Synonyms: course **Antonyms**: disperse

4. **Buffet (verb)**

Meaning; To affect as with blows; to strike repeatedly; to strive with or contend against.



Synonyms: bang, strike **Antonyms:** shield, safeguard

Anecdote (noun) 5.

Meaning; An account which supports an argument, but which is not supported by scientific or statistical analysis.



Synonyms: unreliable, uncertain Antonyms: certain, reliable

6. Abort (verb)

Meaning; To stop or fail at something in the preliminary stages.



Synonyms: halt, stop

Antonyms: begin, continue

7. Vexatious (Adjective)

Meaning; Causing vexation or annoyance; teasing; troublesome.



Synonyms: irksome, annoying **Antonyms**: pleasing, aiding
