### 1. Brace (verb)

**Meaning**; To prepare for something bad, such as an impact or blow.



**Synonyms**: fortify, strengthen **Antonyms**: reduce, weaken

#### Usher (verb) 2.

**Meaning**; to lead or guide somewhere



Synonyms: introduce, lead Antonyms: cease, retract

# Panoply (adjective) 3.

Meaning; A splendid display of something.



**Synonyms**: exhibition

Antonyms: cover

#### 4. Incense (verb)

Meaning; To anger or infuriate



**Synonyms**: anger, enrage **Antonyms**: please, calm

#### 5. Acclaimed (adjective)

Meaning; Greatly praised or lauded, revered, highly respected



**Synonyms**: renowned Antonyms: infamous

## 6. Augury (noun)

Meaning; An omen or prediction; a foreboding



**Synonyms**: sign, warning

Antonyms: ignorance, disregard

# **7**. Dotard (noun)

Meaning; An old person with impaired intellect



Synonyms: old, elder

**Antonyms**: youth, younger
