



1. **Turgid (adjective)**

3. **Relinquish(verb)**

**Synonyms;** renounce

**Antonyms;** retain

4. **Viable (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Able to be done, possible



**Antonyms;** Unfeasible, inoperable

**Synonyms;** practical, workable

5. **Scrupulous(adjective)**

**Meaning;** Exactly and carefully conducted.



**Antonyms;** careless, unaware

**Synonyms;** aware, careful

6. **Vilify (verb)**

**Meaning;** To say defamatory things



**Synonyms;** defame

7. **Dilatory (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Intentionally delaying



**Synonyms;** sluggish, slack
