

1. **Brickbat(noun)**

**Meaning;** A criticism or uncomplimentary remark.



**Antonyms:** compliment, commendation

**Synonyms:** barb, indignity

2. **Meddle(verb)**

**Meaning;** To interfere in or with; to concern oneself with unduly.



**Antonyms:** disregard, overlook

**Synonyms:** intrude, interfere

3. **Treason (noun)**

**Meaning;** An act of treachery, betrayal of trust or confidence.

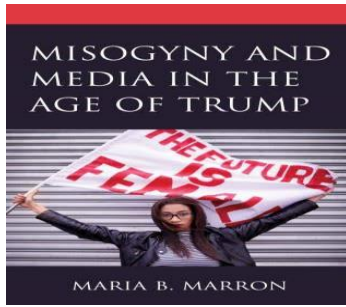


**Synonyms:** treachery, disloyalty

**Antonyms:** loyalty, faithfulness

4. **Misogyny (noun)**

**Meaning;** Hatred of, contempt for, or prejudice against women.



**Synonyms:** hate, distaste

**Antonyms:** fondness, attachment

5. **Palpable(adjective)**

**Meaning;** Capable of being touched, felt or handled; touchable, tangible.



**Synonyms:** apprehensible, detectable

**Antonyms:** imperceptible, insensible

6. **Blatantly (adverb)**

**Meaning;** In a blatant manner; so as to be highly visible or obvious



**Synonyms:** impetuously, roughly

**Antonyms:** pleasingly, nicely

7. **Doyen (noun)**

**Meaning;** A leading light, or exemplar of a particular practice or movement.



**Synonyms:** principal

**Antonyms:** pupil
