Meaning; without the knowledge of



Synonyms: unknown, unaware

Antonyms: known, aware

2. Inferno (noun)

Meaning; A large fire, a conflagration.



Synonyms: disordered, tumultuous

Antonyms: ordered, disciplined

Frenetic (adjective) 3.

Meaning; Fast, harried; having extreme enthusiasm or energy.




Synonyms: hectic, wild

Antonyms: tranquil, settled

4. Flux(noun)

Meaning; The act of flowing; a continuous moving on or passing by



Synonyms: flow, movement Antonyms: calm, stand

Meaning; To hang or attach to, as by a string



Synonyms: adjoin, attach **Antonyms**: ditach, disconnect

6. Mire (verb)

Meaning; To soil with mud or foul matter.



Synonyms: entangle Antonyms: release

7. Ameliorate (verb)

Meaning; To make better, or improve



Synonyms: alleviate Antonyms: aggravate
