

1. **Leverage (noun)**

Meaning; By extension, any influence which is compounded or used to gain an advantage.



Synonyms: influence, dominance

Antonyms: impotence, powerlessness

2. **Exhort (verb)**

Meaning; To urge; to advise earnestly



Synonyms: adjure

Antonyms: discourage

3. **Hurl (verb)**

Meaning; To throw



Synonyms: cast, toss

Antonyms: catch, hold

4. **Tranquility (noun)**

Meaning; the state of being tranquil, the absence of disturbance; peacefulness



Synonyms: calmness

Antonyms: chaos

5. **Vanquish (verb)**

Meaning; To defeat, to overcome



Synonyms: defeat, conquer

Antonyms: surrender, lose

6. **Encrust (verb)**

Meaning; To cover with a hard crust.



Synonyms: cover, hide

Antonyms: reveal, strip

7. **Perfunctory (adjective)**

Meaning; Done only to fulfil a duty, or in a careless manner



Synonyms: careless, inattentive

Antonyms: carefull, attentive
