#### Farmers Protest 2.0: Key Demands Explained

Farmers affiliated with the Kisan Mazdoor Morcha (KMM) and the Samyukta Kisan Morcha (SKM) are marching from Punjab and Haryana towards Delhi to demand key reforms. Their primary demand is the enactment of a law guaranteeing a minimum support price (MSP) for crops, addressing uncertainties in the market.

#### **Guaranteed Minimum Support Price (MSP) Law**

- Demand for a law ensuring MSP for all crops.
- Insistence on legal assurance due to unmet promises by the government.
- Desire for MSP on every crop, citing the government's role in procurement for public distribution.


#### **Implementation** of MS Swaminathan Committee Recommendations

- Urgent implementation of recommendations, including a minimum 50% increase in MSP.
- Acknowledgment of Swaminathan's contribution, recently honored with Bharat Ratna.
- Farmers seek economic security and fair pricing mechanisms.

#### **Other Demands**

- Pension of Rs 10,000/month for farmers above 60 years.
- Stronger actions against accused in the Lakhimpur Kheri
- Grant of land in Delhi for a memorial honoring previous protest "martyrs".
- Justice for victims of the Lakhimpur Kheri tragedy.
- Waiver of farm debts and withdrawal of police cases from previous protests.

Despite government proposals for committee formation, farmer representatives remain skeptical. Political support from AAP and Congress aligns with farmers' cause. Punjab Chief Minister criticizes Harvana's attempts to block the protest march. The steadfastness of the farmers signals a prolonged standoff unless their demands are adequately addressed.



#### PM Modi's UAE Visit

Prime Minister Narendra Modi embarked on a two-day visit to the United Arab Emirates (UAE), where he was warmly received by President Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan. Their cordial meeting included discussions on various fronts, signifying the strengthening of bilateral relations.

# **Supreme Court Collegium Recommends Transfer Of 3 High Court Judges**

The Supreme Court collegium, led by Chief Justice D Y Chandrachud, has recommended the transfer of three high court judges upon their respective requests. The decisions were made in accordance with the interests of better administration of justice and personal reasons cited by the judges.

#### Recommendation 1: Justice Moushumi Bhattacharya

- Request: Justice Moushumi Bhattacharya of the Calcutta High Court has sought a transfer to another high court due to personal reasons, as conveyed in a communication dated February 12, 2024.
- Resolution: The collegium has acceded to Justice Moushumi Bhattacharya's request and recommended her transfer to the High Court for the State of Telangana.

#### **Recommendation 2: Justice Anu Sivaraman**

- Request: Justice Anu Sivaraman has requested a transfer out of the State of Kerala.
- **Resolution:** The collegium has accepted Justice Anu Sivaraman's request and recommended her transfer to the Karnataka High Court.

#### **Recommendation 3: Justice Sujoy Paul**

- Request: Justice Sujoy Paul has sought a transfer because his son practices in the High Court of Madhya Pradesh.
- Resolution: The collegium has resolved to recommend Justice Sujoy Paul's transfer to the High Court for the State of Telangana, considering the better administration of justice.

# Prime Minister Narendra Modi Inaugurates Abu Dhabi's First **Hindu Stone Temple**

In a historic event on February 14, Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated Abu Dhabi's first Hindu stone temple, marking a significant milestone in the UAE's cultural and religious inclusivity. The inauguration ceremony was imbued with devotional chants and witnessed the presence of spiritual leaders from the Swaminarayan sect, highlighting the temple's importance to the global Hindu community.

#### **Global Aarti: A Spiritual Unison**

A highlight of the event was the "Global Aarti," performed simultaneously at over 1,200 temples of the Swaminarayan sect worldwide. This act of global spiritual unity was orchestrated by the Bochasanwasi Shri Akshar Purushottam Swaminarayan Sanstha (BAPS), illustrating the widespread reverence and support for the newly inaugurated temple.

# A Meeting of Faiths

Prior to the inauguration, Prime Minister Modi engaged with individuals from various faiths who played a crucial role in the temple's construction, emphasizing the collaborative spirit that underpinned the project. This interaction underscored the temple's ethos of unity and the bridging of cultural divides.

#### Temple Architecture: A Blend of Tradition and Technology

Located on a 27-acre site near Al Rahba off the Dubai-Abu **Dhabi Sheikh Zayed Highway,** the temple was constructed at a cost of approximately Rs 700 crore. It stands as a testament to ancient architectural principles derived from Hindu scriptures, the Shilpa and Sthapathya Shastras, which guide mandir design and construction. The temple's architecture harmonizes traditional methods with modern scientific techniques, incorporating over 300 high-tech sensors to monitor temperature, pressure, and seismic activity. This innovative approach allows for ongoing research and ensures the temple's safety and sustainability.

#### **Eco-Friendly Construction**

Remarkably, the temple's construction involved no metal use, with fly ash replacing a significant portion of cement in the concrete mix, thereby reducing the carbon footprint. The use of heat-resistant nano tiles and heavy glass panels merges traditional aesthetics with modern functionality, catering to the **UAE**'s extreme temperatures and ensuring visitor comfort.

#### **Craftsmanship and Global Collaboration**

Constructed in the Nagara style of architecture, similar to the Ram Temple in Ayodhya, the temple required 18 lakh bricks, seven lakh man-hours, and 1.8 lakh cubic metres of Rajasthansourced sandstone. The intricate carvings and the marble used in the interiors, mined from Italy and carved in India, showcase the global effort and craftsmanship invested in the temple's creation.

#### A Landmark of Hindu Faith in the Gulf

The temple's establishment, supported by the land donated by the UAE government, marks a new era for the Hindu community in the Gulf region. It joins three other Hindu temples in Dubai but stands out for its size and traditional stone architecture, symbolizing a significant cultural and religious landmark.

### **Prime Minister Modi's UAE Visit**

This visit, Prime Minister Modi's seventh to the UAE since 2015 and his third in the last eight months underscores the deepening ties between India and the UAE. The inauguration of the temple during this visit highlights the mutual respect and acknowledgement of cultural and religious diversity between the two nations.

The Abu Dhabi Hindu temple not only serves as a place of worship but also as a beacon of cultural harmony, architectural innovation, and environmental consciousness. It signifies the growing inclusivity within the UAE and strengthens the bond between India and the Emirates, promising a future of shared values and mutual respect.



- India's flagship instant payment system, the Unified Payments Interface (UPI), along with RuPay card services, is set to be launched in Sri Lanka and Mauritius on February 12. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Sri Lankan President Ranil Wickremesinghe, and Mauritius Prime Minister Pravind Jugnauth will oversee the launch, marking a significant milestone in digital financial integration. - In a development announced by India's Transport Minister Nitin Gadkari, the nation is set to embark on testing (Global navigation satellite system) GNSS-based toll collection on the Mysuru-Bengaluru Expressway.
