

1. **Prudent (Adjective)**

**Meaning;** Practically wise, judicious, shrewd



**Synonyms;** judicious, Shrewd

**Antonyms;** imprudent, unwise

2. **Piquant (Adjective)**

**Meaning;** Favorably stimulating to the palate; pleasantly spicy; tangy



**Synonyms:** spicy

**Antonyms:** favourless

3. **Barrel (verb)**

**Meaning;** To move quickly or in an uncontrolled manner.



**Synonyms:** swift, speedy

**Antonyms:** steady, moderate

4. **Purge (noun)**

**Meaning;** A forcible removal of people, for example, from political activity.




**Synonyms:** expulsion, termination

**Antonyms:** keep, hold

5. **Bout (noun)**

**Meaning;** A period of something, usually painful or unpleasant



**Synonyms:** stretch

**Antonyms:** stagnation

6. **Backstop (noun)**

**Meaning;** A wall or fence behind home plate.



**Synonyms:** prevention, safeguard

**Antonyms:** limitation, sanction

7. **Erect (Verb)**

**Meaning;** To lift up; to elevate; to exalt; to magnify.



**Synonyms:** build
