**Meaning;** A criticism or uncomplimentary remark



**Synonyms:** affront, condemn

**Antonyms:** commendation, compliment

**2. Reprobate (noun)**

**Meaning;** An individual with low morals

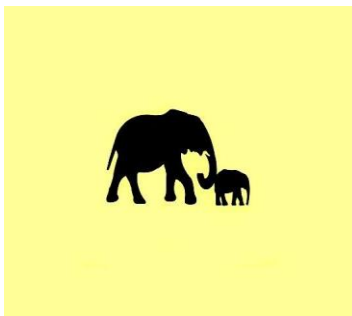


**Synonyms:** wretch, Rogue

**Antonyms:** virtuous, righteous

**3. Nudge (verb)**

**Meaning:** To push against gently, especially in order to gain attention or give a signal.



**Synonyms:** stimulate, promote

**Antonyms:** discourage, demote

**4. Sling (verb)**

**Meaning;** To throw with a circular or arcing motion.

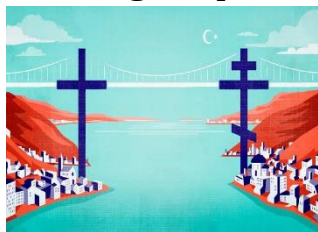


**Synonyms:** hurl, hang

**Antonyms:** keep, leave

**5. Schism (noun)**

**Meaning;** A split or separation within a group



**Synonyms:** separation, distance

**Antonyms:** unified, joint

**6. Conciliatory (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Willing to conciliate, or to make concessions



**Synonyms:** pacifying, appeasing

**Antonyms:** fighting, antagonising

**7. Protracted (adjective)**

**Meaning:** Lasting for a long time or longer than expected or usual.



**Synonyms:** prolonged, sustained

**Antonyms:** intermittent, brief
