He rose to stardom in the late 1950s, with notable films like Hariyali Aur Raasta (1962), Woh Kaun Thi? (1964), and Patthar Ke Sanam (1967).</li> <li>Known for his iconic patriotic films, Manoj Kumar became a beloved figure in Indian cinema.</li> </ul>
2.	<b>Ravikumar</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Veteran actor Ravikumar, known for his romantic roles in Malayalam and Tamil films of the 1970s and 1980s, passed away on April 4, 2025, at age 71 in Chennai.</li> <li>Son of actor Bharathi and producer K.M.K. Menon, founder of Sreekrishna Studio, Ravikumar grew up in a film-centric environment.</li> <li>He rose to fame with Ullasa Yaathra (1975) and made his Tamil debut in Avargal (1977) directed by K. Balachander, leaving a lasting legacy in South Indian cinema.</li> </ul>
3.	<b>Padma Shri Ram Sahay Pandey</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Padma Shri Ram Sahay Pandey, a legendary exponent of Rai folk dance, passed away at the age of 92 in Sagar, Madhya Pradesh.</li> <li>Despite facing poverty, orphanhood, and caste-based taboos, Pandey dedicated his life to revitalizing and promoting Rai dance, transforming it from a stigmatized art form into a celebrated cultural symbol.</li> </ul>
4.	<b>Dadi Ratan Mohini</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dadi Ratan Mohini, born Lakshmi on March 25, 1925 in Hyderabad, Sindh (now in Pakistan), passed away at age 100 on April 8, 2025 in Ahmedabad.</li> <li>As the Chief Administrator of the Brahma Kumaris since 2021, she succeeded Dadi Janki after her passing in 2020.</li> <li>A global spiritual leader, Dadi Ratan Mohini represented the Brahma Kumaris at the World Peace Conference in 1954 and traveled extensively to promote peace, values.</li> </ul>

His rendition of the show's theme song also became a Top 40 hit.</li> </ul>
2.	<b>Val Kilmer</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Renowned American actor Val Kilmer passed away at the age of 65 due to pneumonia, as confirmed by his daughter Mercedes Kilmer.</li> <li>Known for iconic roles in Top Gun, The Doors, Tombstone, and Batman Forever, Kilmer had battled throat cancer for years. Born on December 31, 1959, in Los Angeles, he was the youngest student admitted to Juilliard's Drama Division.</li> <li>His career began on stage before his Hollywood debut in Top Secret! Garimella Balakrishna Prasad	Renowned classical singer and former Asthana Vidwan (court musician)	Garimella Balakrishna Prasad, the renowned classical singer and former Asthana Vidwan (court musician) of Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD), passed away at the age of 76 due to a heart attack in Tirupati. His demise marks the end of an era in Indian classical and devotional music, particularly in the popularization of Annamacharya's compositions.
5.	Syed Abid Ali	former Indian all-rounder	The cricket world mourns the loss of Syed Abid Ali, a former Indian all-rounder, who passed away at 83 in the United States.
