INTRODUCTION

This Booklet gives you detailed information about the competitive examination for recruitment of Junior Associates (Customer Support and Sales) in State Bank of India. This post was advertised in the Employment News/ Rozgar Samachar issued on 16.08.2025 and on the Bank's website https://bank.sbi/careers/current-openings or https://www.sbi.co.in/careers/current-openings. The terms and conditions, period of probation, emoluments etc. were given in the advertisement No.CRPD/CR/2025-26/06. You should ensure that you are eligible in respect of age, educational qualification, nationality as stipulated in the advertisement.

It contains details pertaining to various aspects of the online examination you are going to take and describes the kind of test which will be given to you in the examination. **The assessment will be done online.** You are advised to study this booklet carefully as it will help you in preparing for the examination.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- **1. Particulars to be Noted**: Please note carefully your Roll Number, Date of Exam, Reporting time and venue for the examination given in the call letter.
- 2. Punctuality in Attendance: You must report at the examination venue 15 minutes before the reporting time. Late comers will not be allowed to take the test.
- 3. Call letter: Affix firmly a copy of your recent passport size photograph in the space provided for it in the call letter and bring it with you along with photo identity proof in original and a photocopy when you come to the venue for the examination. Call letter and copy of photo identity proof, which was authenticated/stamped by exam officials at the time of Online Preliminary Examination is also to be brought. You will not be permitted to appear for the examination if you come without the photo identity proof in original and a photocopy, Call letter of Online Main Examination with your photograph affixed thereon, call letter and copy of photo identity proof, which was authenticated/stamped by exam officials during Preliminary Examination. You will be required to sign on your call letter and affix your left thumb impression in the space provided for candidate's signature and thumb impression respectively in the presence of the invigilator in the examination hall. You should submit both your call letters along with the photocopy of photo identity proof and rough sheets at the end of the examination in the examination hall. Signature in CAPITAL LETTERS will not be accepted.
- 4. Candidates who are eligible for and want to use services of scribe are required to submit a Declaration Form (Scribe Declaration Form) along with the Call letters. This can be downloaded from Bank's website.
- 5. For candidates availing scribe in accordance with OM F. No. 29-6/2019-DD-III dated 10.08.2022, shall be allowed scribe facility subject to production of a certificate at the time of online examination to the effect that person concerned has limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf from competent medical authority of a Government healthcare institution as per Appendix I and Appendix II of the said guidelines. Such candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the examination without the specified medical certificate as per Appendix I of the said guidelines. The qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking the examination and the candidate appearing for the exam should submit details of the scribe as per Proforma at Appendix-II of the said O.M.
- 6. During the exam, at any stage, if it is found that scribe is independently answering/ solving the questions himself/ herself, the exam session for such candidates will be terminated, and candidate's candidature will be cancelled. The candidature of such candidates using the services of a scribe will also be cancelled if it is reported/ detected after the examination by the test administrator personnel that the scribe independently answered the questions.
- 7. Compliance with Instructions: You should scrupulously follow the instructions given by test administrators and the invigilators at all the stages of the examination for which you have been called. If you violate the instructions you will be disqualified and may also be asked to leave the examination hall.
- **8. Use of Books, Notes, Calculators & Cell Phones :** No calculator separate or with watch, cell phones, books, smart watch, slide rulers, note books or written notes will be allowed inside the examination hall.
- 9. Do not leave your seat unless you are allowed.

- 10. Use of Stationery: You must bring stationery such as ball point pen with you.
- 11. Rough work to be done on the sheet provided: You should do all the necessary rough work on sheet provided only. You have to write your Roll Number, Registration Number, Name and date of examination on each of the rough sheet used by you. After the test is over, you should submit the rough sheet to the invigilator. Any candidate who does not return the above material or is found to attempt to take or pass on the questions or answers inside or outside the examination hall will be disqualified and the Bank may take further action against him as per rules of the Bank.
- 12. There will be Penalty for wrong answers marked by you in the objective tests. There are five alternative answers to every question of all the tests. For each question for which a wrong answer has been given by you, one-fourth of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty. If a question is left blank, i.e. no answer is given by you, there will be no penalty for that question. If the total of the penalty for test is in fraction, it will be rounded off to the nearest integer. You should therefore be careful in marking your answers.
- 13. Copying / Misconduct / Unfair Practices: If a candidate is/has been found guilty of
 - i) Copying or allowing copying;
 - ii) Using unfair means during the test;
 - iii) Impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person;
 - iv) Misbehaving at the examination venue;
 - v) Disclosing, publishing, reproducing, transmitting, storing or facilitating transmission and storage of test contents in any form or any information therein in whole or part thereof or by any means verbal or written, electronic or mechanical or taking away the papers supplied in the examination hall or found to be in unauthorised possession of test content.
 - vi) Resorting to any other irregular or improper means;
 - vii) Obtaining support of his/her candidature by any means.
 - He/she will, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable to,
 - (a) Disqualification from selection process.
 - (b) Be debarred permanently/for specific period from any examination or selection by the Bank.

Candidates are warned against filling up/furnishing false, tampered/fabricated information or suppressing material information.

The Bank would be analyzing the responses of a candidate with other appeared candidates to detect patterns of similarity. On the basis of such an analysis, if it is found that the responses have been shared and scores obtained are not genuine/valid, the Bank reserves the right to cancel his/her candidature.

- 14. Candidate must submit the following documents before leaving Lab/Venue:
 - Call letters (Preliminary and Mains examination)
 - Photocopy of photo ID proof
 - Rough Sheets
 - Scribe Declaration (if applicable)
- 15. Travelling Allowance shall not be paid: No travelling allowance or other expenses in connection with the examination will be paid. Please note that call letter is not an offer of appointment by SBI.
- 16. The possibility for occurrences of some problem in the administration of the examination cannot be ruled out completely which may impact test delivery and/or result from being generated. In that event, every effort will be made to rectify such problem, which may include movement of the candidates from one venue/lab/computer (node) to others and reconduct of the examination, if considered necessary.
- 17. Following items will not be allowed inside the examination hall (Lab):

Any stationery item like textual material (printed or written), bits of papers, Geometry/Pencil Box, Plastic Pouch, Calculator, Scale, Writing Pad, Pen Drives, Log Table, Electronic Pen/Scanner, any communication device like Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Earphones, Microphone, Pager, Health Band etc. Other items like Goggles, Handbags, Hair-pin, Hair-band, Belt, Cap, any watch /Wrist Watch, Camera, any metallic item, any eatable item opened or packed, water bottle (only transparent water bottle is allowed), Any other item which could be used for unfair means for hiding communication devices like mobile phone, camera, Bluetooth devices etc.

You are advised to avoid wearing ornaments like Ring, Earrings, Nose-pin, Chain/Necklace, Pendants, Badge, brooch etc.

- 18. Any canvassing for selection including change of date, time and venue shall be considered as disqualification.
- 19. Candidates are advised to take note of "The Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act, 2024".
- 20. Candidate Registration:

At the venue, Candidate registration will be done through photo capture and IRIS Scan (Biometric capture of Right thumb impression for VI candidates). Photo captured will be matched with the photo uploaded by the candidate in the application.

IRIS Scan

IRIS will be scanned at the examination venue. Refusal to participate in the process of IRIS scanning on any occasion may lead to cancellation of candidature. With regards to the same, please note the following:

- (a) 'LEFT EYE (IRIS)' will be captured for all the candidates.
- (b) Candidates should remove Contact Lenses and Spectacles while capturing IRIS. Candidates are advised to avoid wearing contact lenses and prefer spectacles.

For VI candidates, Biometric capture of right thumb impression will be done. If fingers are coated (stamped ink/mehndi/coloured...etc.), ensure to thoroughly wash them so that coating is completely removed before the examination day. (Any failure to observe these points will result in non-admittance for the examination).

The candidates will be permitted to move out in an orderly manner one candidate at a time. Please wait for instructions from invigilator and do not get up from your seat until advised.

There will be negative marks for wrong answers in the Objective tests. 1/4th of mark assigned for question will be deducted for each wrong answer.

Candidates are required to score a minimum percentage marks on aggregate (For SC/ST/OBC/PwBD/ESM/DESM candidates, 5% relaxation available thereon). Minimum qualifying marks on aggregate will be decided by the bank. No minimum qualifying marks for individual subject are prescribed. Merit list will be drawn State wise, category wise. Candidates qualified in the test (main examination) will be placed according to their aggregate marks in descending order in respective States and Categories.

Test of specified opted local language:

Those who qualify for selection and produce 10th or 12th standard mark sheet/certificate evidencing having studied the specified opted local language will not be subjected to any Language test. In case of others (qualified for selection), specified opted local language test will be conducted after provisional selection but before joining. Candidates not found to be proficient in specified opted local language would be disqualified.

Provisional Selection (Subject to qualifying specified opted local language)

The marks obtained in the Preliminary Examination (Phase-I) will not be added for the selection and only the aggregate marks obtained in Main Examination (Phase-II) will be considered for preparation of the final merit list. Provisional selection will be made on the basis of candidate's performance in the test (main examination). Final Selection will be subject to:-

- (I) Verification of eligibility for the post and information furnished in the online application.
- (II) Qualifying in test of specified opted local language, where applicable, as detailed above.

Results of the candidates who have provisionally qualified for selection will be made available on the Bank's website.

Wait List:

A wait list of upto 50% of vacancies (State-category wise) will be maintained. Candidates will be released from this waitlist on quarterly basis against non-joining and resignation out of the current batch only, subject to the candidates securing minimum qualifying marks as may be stipulated by the Bank for selection. This wait list will be valid for a period of one year from the date of declaration of final result.

DETAILS ABOUT ONLINE TEST PATTERN

- 1. A **login screen** will be displayed to the candidate. The candidate has to log in using his/her User ID and Password which is provided on the Call Letter.
- 2. After logging in Candidate's profile (Name, Roll No & photograph etc.) will be displayed and the candidate has to confirm the same by clicking on 'I confirm' button confirming the profile is correct.
- 3. Thereafter the instructions will be displayed on the screen.
- 4. Candidate should read the instructions carefully and indicate that he/she has done so by 'checking' (click) the box at the bottom of the screen, after which 'I am ready to begin' button is activated.
- 5. After clicking on the 'I am ready to begin' button the actual test time will begin.
- 6. In Online Main Examination there will be 190 questions and each question is followed by 5 alternatives/ options.
- 7. The version of tests will be English and language as applicable to the State (under which application is registered). The questions will appear in English and the selected language as applicable to the State.
- 8. In case of any discrepancy between English and translated version/language, the translated version/language shall be deemed as reference and English version shall prevail.
- 9. Only one question will be displayed at a time.
- 10. In order to answer a question, candidate has to 'mouse click' the option he/she thinks appropriate/ correct. The alternative which has been clicked on will be highlighted and shall be treated as the answer given by the candidate for the question.
- 11. After selecting an answer for a question candidate should click on the 'SAVE & NEXT' button to save his answer and proceed to the next question. Note that without clicking on 'SAVE & NEXT' button, the answer selected for a question will not be saved.
- 12. In case a candidate does not wish to attempt the question then he/ she should not click on any option for that question. A candidate can choose to deselect his/her answer for a particular question by clicking on the 'CLEAR RESPONSE' button provided against each question.
- 13. In case a candidate wants to skip a particular question and return to it later before submitting his/her test or a candidate 'clicks' (selects) an answer for a particular question but wishes to review it later, he/she may note down the question number on the sheet provided.

In such cases the candidate may also click on the 'MARK FOR REVIEW & NEXT' button. In case an answer has been selected for a particular question which has been marked as 'MARK FOR REVIEW & NEXT', the answer marked will be taken for final evaluation.

- 14. The question numbers of attempted and un-attempted questions are also shown to the right of the screen. A candidate can then click on any of the question numbers to view the question, in order to attempt/ revise his/her answer to the question.
- 15. The Question Palette displayed on the right side of screen will show the status of each question using one of the following symbols:
 - 1 You have not visited the question yet.
 - You have not answered the question.
 - You have answered the question.
 - You have NOT answered the question, but have marked the question for review.
 - The question(s) "Answered and Marked for Review" will be considered for evaluation.

The Marked for Review status for a question simply indicates that you would like to look at that question again. If a question is answered and Marked for Review, your answer for that question will be considered in the evaluation.

- 16. Candidates are not permitted to submit their answers before the entire test time 160 minutes for online main exam is over.
- 17. A candidate can navigate between questions within test by clicking on the question number displayed to the right of the screen.
- 18. When a candidate clicks on a particular question, it takes some time for the question to appear. The time lost is not deducted from the total time allotted for the test.
- 19. Under no circumstances should a candidate click on any of the 'keyboard keys' once the exam starts as this will lock the exam.

About the Submission:

- 1. Candidates are not permitted to submit their answers before the entire test time is over.
- 2. A candidate can only change his/ her answer before clicking the 'Submit' button.
- After the expiry of the exam duration, candidates will not be able to attempt any question or check their answers. A
 candidate's answers would be automatically saved by the computer system even if he has not clicked the 'Submit'
 button.
