Implement means put (a decision, plan, agreement, etc.) into effect. Master means having or showing very great skill or proficiency. Unravel means undo (twisted, knitted, or woven threads).

· Error. After "for", we need a **noun**, not a verb in past form.

· It should be "transfer of government-owned ..."

· **Rule:** Preposition + noun/gerund.

· Wrong: for completed of work.

· Correct: for completion of work.

(D) salt lands

· Correct. "Lands" (plural) is acceptable when referring to **separate tracts of land**, e.g., forest lands, tribal lands, salt lands.

Corrected sentence

The government on Monday modified the guidelines for transfer of government-owned salt lands.

Correct Answer: (c) C
