Ten people are sitting in two parallel rows containing five people each, in such a way that there is an equal distance between adjacent persons. In Row-1, M, N, O, P and Q are seated and all of them face south. In Row-2, E, F, G, H and I are seated and all face north, such that each person in one row sits exactly opposite to a person in the other row, but not necessarily in the same order.

Two persons sit between O and Q but O doesn't sit at the extreme ends. The one who sits opposite to O sits two places away from E. The one who sits opposite to N sits second to the right of G. I sits to the left of G. Q doesn't sit opposite to H. M and H doesn't sit at the extreme ends of the row. P and O are not immediate neighbours.
